BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a regular term of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Union, sitting for the transaction of county business, begun and held at the Court House in the City of La Grande, in said County and State, on Wednesday, the 8th day of October A. D., 1964, the same being the first Wednesday of said month and the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court, when were present:

WHEN, on Thursday, the 8th day of October, A. D., 1964, or the _____ Judicial day of said term, among others, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the vacation of portions of County Roads No 233 and 429

Now at this time, the above entitled matter comes on for hearing upon the report of the County Roadmaster on the proposed vacation of portions of County Roads No 233 and 429, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (SW cor of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 40 East Willamette Meridian, at point A1 of County road No 233 running thence north to A2 of said road, thence on County road No 429 to A 1, thereof, thence to A 2, A 3, A 4, A 5, A 6, A 7, A 8, A 9, A 10 and A 11, thence northeasterly approximately one-fourth mile to the terminus of said county road No 429

and it appearing to the Court from said report that those portions of said roads proposed to be vacated are no longer useful as a part of the general road system of the county and are burdensome to maintain; and it further appearing from the affidavit of posting on file that the County Roadmaster, more than 30 days prior to October 8th, 1964, the date set for hearing the Roadmaster's report, posted three notices of the hearing in the vicinity of that portion of said roads proposed to be vacated, and one notice at the place of holding county court; that said notices remained posted at least 30 days before the date set for said hearing and it further appearing that no person has appeared to object to, or remonstrate, against said vacation;

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the portions of said roads above described, be, and the same are hereby vacated.
