ON THIS DAY this matter came on to be heard upon the sworn petition of Harley McDonald and Lottie McDonald that their farm, located in the East half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 1 North, Range 39, E.W.M., and the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 39, E.M.M., Union County, Oregon, is not reached conveniently by any public road provided by law; and that it is necessary that the public and said McDonalds have ingress to and egress from said farm and asking the Court to appoint a Board of County Viewers to view out and locate a suitable public road from their farm to the nearest point practical on a public road and to assess the damage to be sustained thereby.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Oscar Mannon, REX Roulet and John Wealty, be and they are hereby appointed as a Board of County Viewers, and they are hereby directed to meet at the McDonalds property at 10 A.M., on the 22nd day of August, 1966, and then and there to view out, locate and mark out a suitable public road not exceeding sixty (60) feet wide having regard to all surrounding circumstances and conditions so as to do the least damage to the land through which the road is located from the farm of the petitioner to the nearest point practical on the County Road; and to assess any damages sustained thereby; and to make a report to the Court at its next regular session as to where the public road has been located, and the amount of damages that may be assessed, and the persons entitled to such

damages, if any.
