WHEREAS, it appears that said County Road has not been a part of the County Road System for over twenty five (25) years, and


WHEREAS, there being only two land owners (Homer & Kay Abell and J.C. Williams) affected by the closure, and their being in full accord, and,

WHEREAS, the public will be benefited by the closure of the road, and,


WHEREAS Boise Cascade has not responded to the closure within the allotted time, and,
