WHEREAS, a petition for vacation was submitted by Clarence H. and Imogene Magill to vacate the following:

That portion of Deschutes Avenue lying between the western edge of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, and the east right-of-way line of Main Street (County Road No. 44);

That portion of Crestone Avenue lying between the westerly right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad, and the east right-of-way line of Main Street (County Road No. 44) including the southerly half of Crestone Avenue inside the city limits of Elgin;

That portion of Front Street lying between Block numbered five (5) and Block numbered six (6) in said plat of Hugs' Addition.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners advertised and held a public hearing on April 3, 1991, 10:00 a.m. to accept testimony, deliberate and potentially make a decision;

SECTION 1: ROAD VACATION

The following described property is vacated:

That portion of Deschutes Avenue lying between the western edge of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, and the east right-of-way line of Main Street (County Road No. 44);

That portion of Crestone Avenue lying between the westerly right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad, and the east right-of-way line of Main Street (County Road No. 44) including the southerly half of Crestone Avenue inside the city limits of Elgin;

That portion of Front Street lying between Block numbered five (5) and Block numbered six (6) in said plat of Hugs' Addition.
