WHEREAS, it appears to the County Court of Union Cunty, Oregon, that a portion of the County Road No 233 and a protion of County Road No 429, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter (SW cor of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section 8, Township 4 South, Range 40 East., Willamette Meridian, at point A1 of county road No 233 running thence north of A2 of said road, thence on county road No 429 to A1, thereof, thence to A 2, A 3, A 4, A5, A6, A 7, A 8, A 9, A 10, and A 11, thence northeasterly apporximately one-fourth mile to the terminus of said county road No 429,

and is useless as a part of the general road system of Union County and has not been used by the public as a part of the general road system of Union County; and would therefore now be burdensome to maintain.

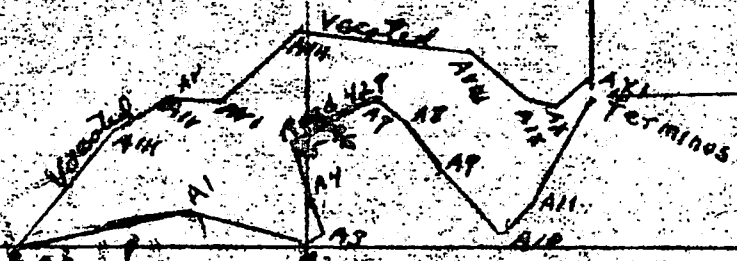
