This matter coming on now to be heard by the Hon. County Court, the same being in relation to the suit brought by A. J. Lansing, Road Supervisor vs. King Lock, for road taxes and judgment being entered of record in the Circuit Court of Union County, Oregon, and docketed in the Civil Book of said Court, wherein King Lock, as plaintiff, in Review proceedings, and his said writ of Review being explained by said Circuit Court, judgment was rendered in his favor for his costs and disbursements and atty. fee, the same amounting to the sum of \$74. And the Court being fully advised therein, it is hereby ordered and adjudged that the same be paid and the Clerk is authorized to draw a warrant in favor of E. W. Barber, Attorney for said King Lock, for the said sum of \$74, out of the County Fund.

In the matter of changing  
the County road  
between Perry and Oroville.

Now at this time it appearing to the Court that the County road between Perry and Oroville along the railroad is unusable for travel on account of several difficult and dangerous crossings on the same over said railroad and it further appearing to the Court that the O. R. & N. Co. and the G. & A. L. Co. propose to assist in the work, if the County will undertake to make a change in said County road so as to avoid the several crossings thereon therefore it is hereby ordered that W. D. Lancel, County Commissioner, and he is hereby authorized and directed to secure from the owners of the land the right of way for said road, estimate the expense of making said proposed change thereon, and to confer with said O. R. & N. Co. and the G. & A. L. Co. about raising the necessary funds to meet the expense of making the proposed change of said road and to superintend the work on behalf of the County, when the same is undertaken.

when completed to close the old road.

Trump is signed by a large number of the citizens and Taxpayers of said District and that he is a suitable person for said appointment. It is therefore considered and ordered that the said E. F. Trump be and he is hereby appointed Constable for South La Grande Justice of the Peace and Constable District for the ensuing two years

In the matter of building  
and opening road on Grande  
Ronde River at Perry

It appearing to the Court at this time that there is a large amount of subscription work to be collected and applied on the new road on the south side of Grande Ronde River near Perry but not enough to complete the opening up of said road, that it will be necessary for the County to pay for a portion of the said work. It is therefore considered and ordered that C. H. Lansing, Supervisor of Road District No. 39 be appointed to collect the subscriptions and donations and apply the same when collected on said road, that he open up said road for travel and present all necessary bills to this Court

In the Matter of Vacating  
portions of the County Road between  
Perry and Crowell along the  
Grande Ronde River }

It appearing to the County Court that the County road heretofore petitioned for by Jas Minnaugh et al. viewed and surveyed on the 18th day of December 1897 and described by the Surveyors field notes as commencing at the north east corner of the south west quarter section thirty five township two south range thirty seven east and terminating at a point on the old traveled road near the north east corner of the south east quarter section thirty six said township and range has been opened up for travel and the necessary bridges across the Grande Ronde River have been completed. Now therefore in pursuance of an agreement entered into between N D Arnold on the part of the county and W B Kennedy on the part of the O. R. & N. Railway Company and in consideration of said agreement the terms thereof to be complied with on the part of the Railway Company upon the making of this order

It is hereby considered and ordered that all portions of the old traveled county road crossed by the track of the said railway company between the point of beginning and terminus of the new road herein before described is hereby vacated and a strip of ground 50 feet in width on each side of said railway track is hereby granted to the said railway company and the said railway company shall have the exclusive right to the use and control thereof

Comes now John Graham one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County Road and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others praying for the location and establishment of a County Road described as follows: to wit
