WHEREAS, ORS 310.330 requires a Court Order specifying the date and levy amount of an election to be delivered to the County Clerk as provided in general election laws, and

WHEREAS, the County Court has approved by motion a special 3-year levy to be submitted to the voters of Union County on March 27, 1984 from 8:00 A.M to 8:00 P.M. in the amount of \$669,000. This special 3-year levy will be used for criminal law enforcement operations.

THEREFORE, it is HEREBY ORDERED that the Budget Officer of Union County is directed to file with the County election authority, no later than thirty-four (34) day preceding March 27, 1984, notice of the County's intent to hold this special election, together with a certified copy of the ballot title and a copy of this Court Order as adopted by the County Court.
