

SECOND JUDICIAL DAY.

THURSDAY, JANUARY 7th, 1915.

In the matter of the application of D.H. Procter for leave to lay water pipe for irrigation purposes along the county road.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing upon the application of D.H. Procter for leave to lay water pipe for irrigation purposes along the county road beginning at or near the Southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33, Tp. 2 S. R. 38 E.W.M. and running a distance of 40 rods north along the east side of the county road, and the court being fully advised,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application be granted, and that said D. H. Procter be and he is hereby granted the right to lay a six inch pipe along said county road, said pipe to be placed about 16 inches under ground and to be so kept and maintained that it will not interfere in any way and will not result in damage to the county road.

In the matter of the application of E.E. Miller for leave to construct a stockway under the county road.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing upon the application of E.E. Miller for leave of this court to construct a stockway under the county road at or near the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 23, Tp. 2 S. R. 39, for the purpose of obtaining water for stock use, and it appearing to the court that such stockway will be of great benefit to the applicant and that the applicant has agreed that such stockway when constructed will in no manner impede or interfere with public travel or do damage to the county road.

It is therefore ORDERED that this application be allowed and that said applicant, E.E. Miller, confer with the County court as to the manner of constructing said stockway before the actual construction of the same.

In the matter of the payment of the balance of appropriation for field work etc.

It appearing to the court at this time that there is a balance of \$205.00 due the Oregon Agricultural College for extension field work of the appropriation heretofore made for such purpose, and that the same should now be paid.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the Clerk of this court be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General fund of the county in the sum of \$205.00 in favor of said Oregon Agricultural College as the balance and final payment of the appropriation heretofore made for field work for the year 1914.
