Now at this time this matter comes on to be heard upon the application of J. K. Romig for permission to erect poles and string wires thereon along, over and across the County Roads and Public Streets between the points hereinafter described, for the purpose of carrying electric currents for maintaining and operating telegraph and telephone lines and for such other purposes as electricity is now or hereafter may be applied.

The points to be connected by said electric lines as set forth in the petition are as follows: From La Grange to Hallows bridge via Island City, Alice, Dublin, Elyria and intermediate points with either the main line or a branch line to Summerville, as deemed most expedient.

From La Grange to Niagara via Cro Well and Perry.
From La Grange to Cove; From La Grange to the main crossing of North Powder River via of Union, Telocassite and North Powder. the said line to go by way of Phy's point or a more direct route as may be hereafter determined. And the Court being fully advised in the premises, It is therefore hereby ordered and considered that said permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to said J. K. Romig his successors and assigns, the poles to be erected and the wires strung in such manner as not to obstruct or delay public travel.
