WHEREAS, Holmes Road as herein described:

Commencing at the northwest corner of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, T3S, R38EWM said point being the west boundary of Holmes Road, and north boundary of road right of way as described to State of Oregon Highway on deed RW29304.

Thence east 40 feet to the east boundary of Holmes road as described as public usage road, and point of beginning of this description. From point of beginning so determined a strip of land 40 feet of width on the west and 20 feet on the east of the following described center line of Holmes road.

thence N00°03'42"W a distance of 1924.84 feet to the southerly right of way line of the Oregon State right of way of the Island City Highway.

Described strip being the west 60 feet of NW 1/4 SE1/4 and SW1/4NE1/4 of Section 4, T3S, R38EWM.
