KNIGHT COUNTY ROAD)

WHEREAS, that portion of County Road No. 138, which extends easterly from the West line of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 1 North, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridan; that is any portion of said road as same may traverse the following lands; SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14; S 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 1 North, Range 40 EWM in Union County, Oregon, is claimed to be a duly and dedicated county road, and

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the Union County Court requesting the above described portion of County Road No. 138 be vacated for the reason that it is not used as a part of the County road system, it is useless as a part of the general road system, dangerous, and an unnecessary maintenance burden upon the County, and the public and the County would be benefited by its vacation and persons owning land in the area which would utilize the Road for access have secured private assessments for access and,

WHEREAS, the County Court, on its own motion, in reponse to the Petition filed herein, desires to vacate said portion of County Road No. 138 known as Knight Road as the same appears of the attached map, marked Exhibit A and

PURSUANT TO a resolution adopted by the County Court of Union County, Oregon, on the 7 day of April , 1976 adn in accordance with ORS 368.570, IT IS HEREBY,

ORDERED that the County Roadmaster examine that portion of County Road NO. 138 known as the Knight Road located, to-wit,

Any portion of said road which extends easterly from the west line of the SE ¼ SE ¼ of section 14, Township 1 North Range 40 E. of the Willamette Meridan; that is any portion of said road as same may traverse the following lands: SE ¼ SE ¼ of Section 14 and S ¼ SW ¼ of section 13 Township 1 North Range 40 E. of the Willamette Meridan located in Union County, Oregon.

As the same appears on the attached Exhibit A, and make a report in writing on the Road on or before May 1, 1976.

This report shall include the opinion of the Roadmaster as to whether the Road should be vacated, whether the Road is or has been used as a part of the County road system, whether it will be available to preserve the Road as a part of the general road system in the future, or whether the public will be benefited by the vacation of said County Road, and all other facts, matters and things which are of importance to the County Court. Upon completion of the report, it shall be filed with the County Clerk with a copy provided to the Union County District Attorney.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Wednesday, June 2, 1976 at 3:00 o'clock P. M., in the County Court Room in the Courthouse, in the City of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for hearing said report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Roadmaster of Union County, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to cause notice of the hearing to be given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, Union County Courthouse, and at three public places in the Vicinity of the Road, at least thirty (30) days before the date set for hearing, and prove that the notice has been given shall be made by the Roadmaster of Union County, Oregon.

ORDER OF ROAD VACATION

On this day this matter come on for hearing and the Court in session pursuant to ORS 368.570 and ORS 368.580 did consider the matter of the vacation of that portion of County Road No.138 more particularly described as:

Any portion of the alleged county road no. 138 which extends easterly from the west line of the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 14 T1N Range 40 EWM; that is any portion of the said road as same may traverse the following lands: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14 and S 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13 all situated in T1N Range 40 EWM all situated in Union County Oregon as the same appears on attached Exhibit A.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The County Court finds that the said County Road is burdensome to maintain, is not needed as a part of the county Road System, and has not been used as a part of said County Road System for many years and the above described is not an intergral part of the County Road System.

The Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County road, and depending thereon for access will be adversely affected by its closure.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of the County Road No. 138 hereinabove described be vacated pursuant to the map attached hereto marked Exhibit "A".
