WHEREAS, Union County adopted revisions to its Land Use Plan and Zoning Ordinance maps on November 2, 1983;

WHEREAS, Union County adopted the City of La Grande Comprehensive Plan and City of La Grande Zoning Ordinance - Series 1983 and their associated maps on December 21, 1983;

WHEREAS, the newly adopted City of La Grande plan and zoning maps deleted land previously identified by La Grande for urban growth on December 21, 1983, thereby placing this land in Union County's planning and zoning jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the City of Island City adopted its current Land Use Plan on September 29, 1980;
