to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do _____ bargain, sell and convey
unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

_____ A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet on each side
of the center line of the La Grande-Joseph Highway, as surveyed over and
across the E. 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 14, and the S. E. 1/4 of Sec.
11 T. 1. N. R. 39. E. of the W. M., and more particularly described as
follows: _____

_____ Beginning at the intersection with the South boundary line of the
J. N. Chandler property and the La Grande-Joseph Highway, at Station 1293
plus 15.3 of the survey of the center line of said Highway, which station
is approximately 553.1 feet South and 193.7 feet East of the 1/16 corner
at the N. W. cor. of the East 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 14 T. 1. N. R.
39 E., W. M.; running thence N. 48.34' E. 629.4 ft., thence a 16 degree
