This Indenture, WITNESSETH, That Edward Blaser

and Lucina Blaser his wife, for the consideration of One dollar
and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey
unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet on each side
of the center line of the La Grande-Joseph Highway as surveyed over and
across the S. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 2 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M.
and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the West boundary line of the
Edward Blaser property and the La Grande-Joseph Highway, at Station 1653
plus 50 of the survey of the center line of said Highway, which station
is approximately 916.5 ft. North and 4.9 ft. West of the corner of Sect-
ions 2, 3, 10, and 11 T. 1 N. R. 40, E. W. M. running thence on an 8 degree
curve right 386.6 ft., thence S. 77 36' E. 516.6 ft., thence on a 10 de-
gree curve right 501.8 ft., to an intersection with the East boundary line
of the Edward Blaser property at Station 1667 plus 55 of said survey, which
station is approximately 932.7 North and 1355.1 ft. East of the Corner
of Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11 T. 1, N. R. 40 E. W. M. containing 1.94 acres
more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said
Union County and the public therein forever, and Edward Blaser

and Lucina Blaser do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County
that they are the owner^s in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances
