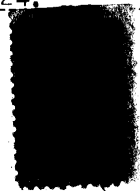

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That-----William C. Hill-----

and-----Laura B. Hill----- his wife, for the consideration of-----

them-----paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do----- bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

All that part of the property of Wm. C. Hill, in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 34, T. 1. N.R. 39 E.W.M, within a strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the La Grande-Joseph highway, as surveyed and staked across said property; said center line being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a point designated as station 1046 / 69.5 on said center line survey, said point being approximately 1236 feet north and 3144 feet east of the section corner common to sections 3, and 4, T. 1 S.R.39 E.W.M and sections 33 and 34 T. 1. N.R. 39 E.W.M; thence on a 1 degree curve to the right, whose tangent at above named point bears N. 22 degrees 32' East a distance of 226.7 feet; thence north 24 degrees 48' east a distance of 333.7 feet; thence on a 3 degree curve to the right a distance of 200 feet; thence north 30 degrees 48' east a distance of 151 feet; thence on an 8 degree curve to the left a distance of 295.8 feet; thence north 7 degrees 08' east a distance of 456.6 feet; thence on a 16 degree curve to the left a distance of 357.5 feet; thence north 50 degrees 04' east a distance of 37.5 feet; thence on a 12 degree curve to the right a distance of 311.7 feet; thence north 12 degrees 40' west a distance of 301.6 feet thence on a 7 degree curve to the right a distance of 315.3 feet; thence north 9 deg. 24' east a distance of 156.7 feet to a point designated as station 1078 / 00 on said center line survey said point being approximately 4152 feet north and 3334 feet east of the above described section corner. Said parcel of land containing 3.92 acres more or less.

In the matter of the settlement with D. M. Conklin for Right-of-way according to decision of the Board of Arbitrators.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that the above entitled matter be and the same is hereby continued for the term.

In the matter of the acceptance of the deeds of Wm. C. Hill and wife and Sven Jansen and wife to rights-of-way for the La Grande Joseph Highway.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the deeds of Wm. C. Hill and wife and Sven Jansen and wife to rights-of-way across their land for the La Grande-joseph highway and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire the lands described in said deeds,

It is CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said deeds be accepted and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on the Road Bond Fund of the County in favor of W. C. Hill and wife in the sum of \$2,000.00 and in favor of Sven Jansen and wife in the sum of \$224.00 in payment for said lands.

In the matter of the opening of the ballot boxes.

Now at this time upon application of the County Clerk, it is ORDERED that said Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to open the ballot boxes and burn the ballots and stubs remaining therein from the last election and to prepare said boxes for use at the Primary Election to be held May 19th, 1922.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that the same Polling Places used at the last election be and the same are hereby designated as the Polling Places for the Primary Election to be held May 19th, 1922.

In the matter of the road petitioned for by John B. Scott, et al.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that the above entitled matter be and the same is hereby continued for the term.

Thereupon the Journal of today's proceedings was read, approved, and is here now signed, and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.
