to her paid, has bargained and sold, and by these presents do ~~all~~ bargain, sell and convey

unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

All that part of the property of J. D. McKennon Estate in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T 2 SR 37 EWM, lying south of the southerly right of way line of the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Co, included in a strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet in width on each side of the center line of the Oro Dell-La Grande section of the Old Oregon Trail, as the same is now located over and across from the north side to the east side of said property, said center line being particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the south boundary line of the right of way of the OWR & N Co approximately 490 feet north and 2552 feet west of the quarter section corner common to section 31 T 2 SR 38 EWM, and section 6, T 3 SR 38 EWM; running thence south 54 deg. 43' east 12 feet, more or less, to station 314 - 30 of said center line; thence southeasterly on a 286.5 foot radius curve to the left 115 feet, more or less, to the east line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ section 36 T 2 SR 37 EWM, at a point approximately 440 feet north, as measured along said east line from the SE corner of section 36, T 2 SR 37, EWM. Said strip of land containing 0.17 acres, more or less.
