THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That Jas. Goble

and Estella Goble his wife, for the consideration of

to paid, ha... bargained and sold, and by these presents do... bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet in width, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Union-Medical Springs Market Road, from Survey Station 978/76.0 to Survey Station 989/38.1, said center line being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point in the present County Road No. 238, which said point is located West 215 feet from the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 24 Tp 6S R41 EWM, and running thence to the right on a 955.0 feet radius curve a distance of 601.4 feet; thence S 10° 54' W a distance of 81.3 feet; thence to the left on a 286.5 feet radius curve a distance of 310.0 feet; thence S 51° 06' E a distance of 34.4 feet; thence to the right on a 358.1 feet radius curve a distance of 35.0 feet to a point South 980.0 feet from the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 24 Tp 6S R41 EWM. Said strip of land contains 1.46 acres more or less. The above description includes .70 acres which is contained in the present County road No. 238.
