

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That The Odd Fellows Cemetery Association of La Grande, Oregon in consideration of the sum of One Hundred & 00/100 DOLLARS TO IT IN HAND PAID, and the further express agreement by the Grantee, that the property conveyed shall be used for cemetery purposes only, and that the same shall conform at all times to the printed rules and regulations of said association for the care of the buried dead, and the grounds embraced in the said cemetery, as promulgated by said Association, do hereby grant, set apart and convey to Union County Oregon

THE FOLLOWING PARCEL of ground, to-wit:

The ~~..... of Lot No. All~~ of Block No. 279 of the recorded plat and survey of The Odd Fellows Cemetery Association of La Grande, Oregon, and all right, title and interest the said Association may have in the said parcel of ground, excepting always, that said grantor The Odd Fellows Cemetery Association of La Grande and its successors, reserve the right to restrain the use of said parcel of ground other than for cemetery purposes, to protect and regulate the lawful use and management of the cemetery grounds most conducive to the welfare and due respect of all concerned, and arrange for the proper burial of the incoming dead and care of their graves, not inconsistent with legal private rights.

~~THE ODD FELLOWS CEMETERY ASSOCIATION hereby undertake and agree perpetually to maintain, care for and keep in good condition the turf, shrubbery and monuments upon said Lot, provided, that said Association undertakes and agrees to expend annually, in such maintenance and care, not more than the income from said sum at the current rate of interest~~
