

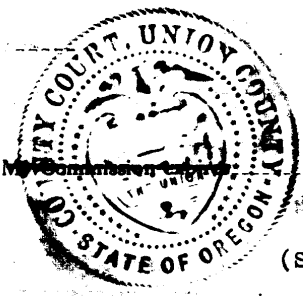

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That Charles F. Oswald

and Ella F. Oswald his wife, for the consideration of

One dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS

to us paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto

the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A parcel of land lying in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 12 T. 1S. R38 E.W.M. of Union County, Oregon.

The parcel of land being that portion of the foregoing described property included in a strip of land thirty (30) feet in width lying on the Easterly side of the Center Line of the Imbler-Summerville Road as said road has been relocated, which Center Line is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is Engineer's Center Line Station 144+50 opposite and thirty (30) feet distant from which point the Easterly line of the said strip of land intersects the Southerly line of said property, said intersection being 1195 feet East of the South quarter corner of Sec. 12 T. 1S. R38 E.W.M., thence on a 38197.2 ft. radius curve left (the long cord of which bears N 26°34'45"W) 776.29 ft; thence on a spiral curve left (the long cord of which bears N 27°14'15"W) 150 ft; thence N 27°16'30"W 65.37 ft; to Engineer's center Line Station 144+41.66 at which Station the Northly end of said strip of land lies at right angles to said Center Line.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains 0.68 acres, of which 0.55 acres lie within the existing R/W, the title to which hereby is acknowledged to be in the public, and 0.13 acres lie outside of the existing R/W.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said Union County and the public therein forever, and we the said Charles F. Oswald and Ella F. Oswald, his wife do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County

that we are the owners in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances except

SECOND JUDICIAL DAY

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 7th, 1918

In the matter of the purchase of land from C. F. Oswald for road purposes

Now at this time it appearing to the court that it would be a public benefit to change the route of the "Dry Creek" road near Summerville, Oregon, and that such change will necessitate the purchase of a right of way through the land of C. F. Oswald, and the said C. F. Oswald having tendered to this court a good and sufficient deed to the land necessary for said right of way,

It is CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the said deed be accepted and the Clerk of this court is hereby ORDERED and directed to draw a warrant on the general fund of the county in the sum of \$25.00 in payment therefor. It is further ORDERED that said deed be recorded in the deed records of Union County, Oregon.

In the matter of the application of the Union County War Board for an appropriation for organization purposes

Now at this time is presented the petition of Geo. T. Cochran and other taxpayers of Union County praying that an appropriation of \$250.00 be made by this court to be used in defraying the expense of organizing Union County into Districts for the purpose of managing the various drives for money which the war this country is now engaged in will necessitate, and it appearing to the Court that said appropriation is necessary in order to carry on said work efficiently,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application be granted, and the Clerk of this Court is hereby ORDERED and directed to draw a warrant on the general fund of the county in the sum of \$250.00 in favor of J. F. Hutchinson, Treasurer of the Union County War Board.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until Wednesday, February 13th, 1918 at 9 o'clock A. M.
