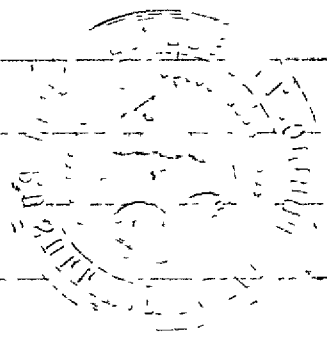

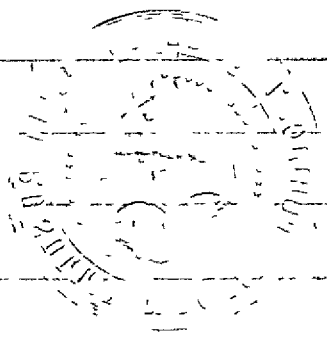

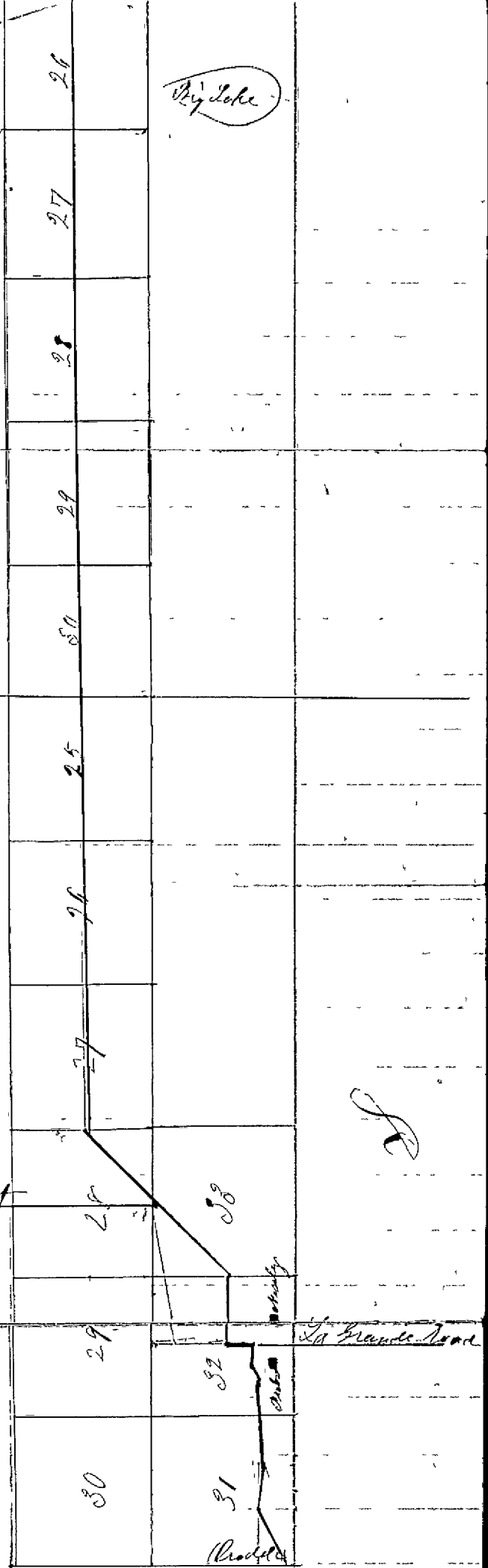

Be it remembered that at a regular session of the Board of Commissioners for Union County in State of Oregon held at the Court House in the Town of La Grande on the 9th day of March A.D. 1865, Present J.W. Lichtenthalen Esq. Judge, Daniel Payton Commissioner, J. Geed Sheriff & A.L. Thomas Clerk; The following proceedings were had.

A Road petition was presented by Charles Good-nough praying for the extension of the County Road running from Powder River touching at La Grande and terminating at the crossing of Grand Round River near Fox's Mill, said extension to commence at "Oridell" (the present terminus) and running on the north side of Grand Round River intersect the Walla Walla Road near Mitchel; on the Big Lake on Grande Ronde River. Said Petition was signed by seventy six of the citizens interested in said Road.

Road Viewers Viewers appointed to meet on the 25th day of March and locate said Road as follows to wit; Benjamin Kendall, J. R. Ellison, and Palmer, Surveyor, Josiah Leabo.

School lands A General Order for the sale of all school Lands By the Superintendent of common schools, as far as such Lands may come into market, was made by the Board.

Licence A Signon licence was granted W. B. Layton for the space of six months, on his filing in the clerks office a Bond of \$500. with two sureties for the security of good conduct as required by law. Together with his Petition to the court, accompanied by a notice and his affidavit as to posting same according to law.

Be it remembered that at a regular session of the Board of Commissioners for Union County & State of Oregon held at La Grande on this 5th day of April A. D. 1865, Present J. W. Lichtenhan Esq. Judge, Daniel Payton, & Samuel Cannon Esq. Commissioners, J. Geer Sheriff, and S. L. Thomas Esq. Clerk, the following business was had to wit:

W. W. Rose was appointed ~~was appointed~~ to serve as Justice of the Peace for Augusta Precinct in the place of Alexander Abel who refused to accept the appointment.

M. Baker presented a road petition praying for the location of a road commencing one fourth of a mile south of the N. W. corner of section No 4 in Township No 2 S. of Range No 38 East, thence due east from said point to intersect the Walla Walla Road, running from Walla Walla to Boise city. (Petition Granted)

The following persons were appointed ~~to serve~~ as viewers on said road, John R. Kellogg, M. C. Grant, Thomas Williamson, and Daniel Chaplin, for Surveyors, Viewers to meet on the 25th of April, 1865.

The viewers appointed at last term to locate a road from Crodell to intersect the Walla Walla Road near Mitchell on the Big Lake, were not prepared to report on account of the inclemency of the weather, and were given until the 26th of April to meet, with Daniel Chaplin as Surveyor vice J. R. Leabo who declined the appointment.

The Sheriff not being prepared to make his return of delinquent tax payers was ordered to make said return on the first Monday in May next A. D. 1865. In the matter of the return of the State tax it was ordered that the amt. of State tax per assessment Roll be invested in Baker County Orders & returned to said Baker County under direction of the Commissioners.

Be it remembered that on the first day of May A.D. 1865 at a regular session of the Board of Commissioners for Union Co. held at the Court House in La Grande Present Dant Payton Saml. Hannan Commissioners J. Eyr Shiff and S. L. Thomas Clerk, the following business was had, to wit:

A jury list of (200) Two Hundred names was selected from the assessment for 1864 for the ensuing year.

The viewers appointed at last term to view road from Procell to Big Lake on C.R. have reported a practicable route and that said road was much needed for the convenience of a large portion of the inhabitants of the valley. Report was received

Frederick Pribst, J. G. Kessley and Kessley on line of said road, laid in a bill for damages and the Board appointed Benj. Brown, Wm. Cottle and John P. Kellogg to assess said damages on the 15th day of May and report at the June term.

E. B. Patterson & Co. who were authorized by the Board to procure Baker Co. Scrip, reported \$124.92 @ 60¢ on the \$ and an order for that amt. was ordered issued on receipt of the warrants.

Total amt. of Baker Co. warrants reported \$359.13. (Court Adjourned) (May 2nd P.M. Court Convened)

The Clerk was ordered to forward to Baker Co. Clerk, an official statement of money drawn from Union Co. for the subsistence of the Volunteers of the two counties.

S. Bunnester Petitioned for Liquor License which was granted, and License ordered issued on the filing of the Treasurer's receipt for the money.

By order of the Board Daniel Chaplin was appointed County Surveyor.

Be it remembered that on this 6th day of September A. D. 1865 at a regular term of the Commissioners Court held at the Court House in La Grande Union County and State of Oregon Present J. P. Argyring Judge, J. C. Cur Sheriff & J. L. Thomas Clerk the following proceedings were had, to wit;

J. R. Ellison School Superintendent presented his annual report which was approved by the Board & placed on file.
 By order of the Board the Resignation of Mr. Ellison was accepted and P. C. Shupe was appointed as his successor.

Petition from the citizens of Post Cove for a Co. Road running from Wells in Grand Ronde Valley to intersect the Road ^{improving} from La Grande to the Cove & which was laid over at last term was taken up & granted and C. W. Wells, Saml Chaplin and Mack B. Rives were appointed viewers, with S. Chaplin for Surveyor Viewers to meet on the 22nd of Sept.

The viewers appointed at the April term to view Road petitioned for at that term running from N. W. Corner of Section four in Town 2 S. & Range 38 E. running east from said point to intersect S. Walla Walla Road having failed to report, the following persons were appointed to serve as viewers on said Road & Report at next term. J. S. Kinsey, J. W. Dickey, & Edward Lindsey with Saml Chaplin as Surveyor & Viewers to meet on the 16th of Sept.

By virtue of an act of the legislature passed Jan'y 30th A.D. 1853, empowering the Board of Co. Commissioners of each County at the Sept. Session of their Board to change the rate of taxation for Co. purposes in proportion to the amount of property assessed, and the indebtedness of the County.
