Fannings farm and thence Southerly to a point on the Ordell and Wainwain Road by the nearest best Road available" which said petition was duly accompanied with notice affidavit and bond said petition was granted and J. S. Fiskett Geo W. Clark and J. M. Conner was appointed as Jurors to meet at a point of beginning on the 28th day of Jan 1867 S. Chaplin was appointed as Surveyor for said Road

In the matter of a

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for the location of a County road beginning at or near the Lake House on the Walla Walla Road in Wagon County running thence West or Westwily to a point for its termination on the road as recently laid Out from Lafrande to Sumnerville by the nearest best route available" which said petition was duly accompanied with notice affidavit and bond said petition was granted and J. B. Fiskett Geo W. Clark and J. D. Melrose was appointed as Jurors to meet at a point of beginning On the 28th day of Jan 1867. S. Chaplin was appointed as Surveyor for said Road

At a regular term of the County Commissioners Court of Union County Oregon began and held at the Court House in La Grande on the 2^d day of April 1867. There was present J. Richardson County Judge, P. J. Norton Commissioner, A. C. Craig Sheriff, E. J. McComas Clerk

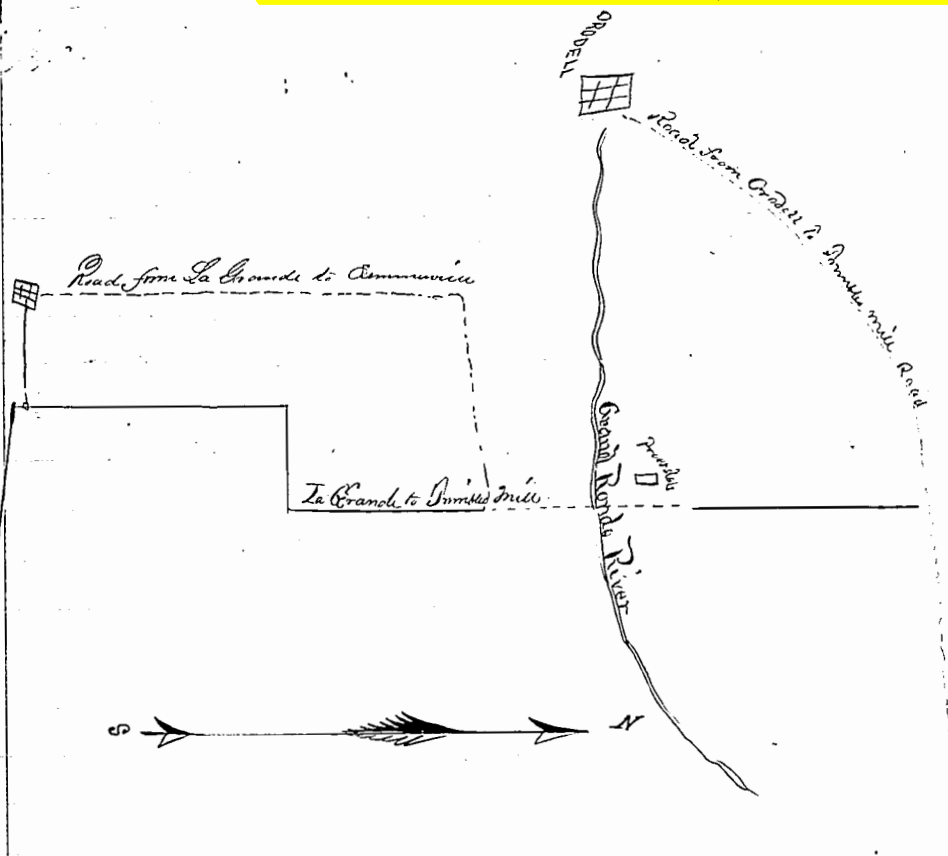
