the 20th day of March 1882
as mentioned in your order

the Surveyor proceeded to view
survey, and lay-out said road.
We found the road to be
located on as good ground
as the section of country over
which we travelled would
admit of and taking into
consideration the necessity of
a direct road from Oro See
to Island City we recommend
that it be established as a

On this day came A. J.
 Hughes who presents to the Court the petition
 of himself and twenty seven others praying
 for the location and establishment of a County
 Road as follows, to wit: Commencing at the
 North west corner of the County Bridge a-
 cross Grande River at Oro Dell in said
 County thence in an easterly direction a-
 long the North side of Grande Rivere River
 to the North end of the County bridge across
 Grande Rivere River at Island City and
 is satisfactorily appearing to the Court, from
 proof filed herein, that due notice of the
 pendency of this proceeding has been
 given as by law required, that more
 than twelve of said petitioners are legal
 householders residing in the vicinity of
 said road, and that a good and sufficient
 bond has been filed. It is therefore
 ordered by the Court that William Lehman
 George Bartmes & W. D. Buchanan be appointed
 viewers and Eugene Chase Surveyor to view
 survey and report upon said proposed
 road and that they meet at Oro Dell on the
 21st day of March A.D. 1882 and duly qual-
 ify before entering upon the discharge of
 their duties in this behalf.

In the Matter of the Petition

Now at this time
is presented the written motion of A. J. Hughes
on behalf of the petitioners to vacat all that
portion of the foot Hill County Road extending from
Oro Dell to the N W corner of the N E 1/4 of Sec. 31
in Township 2 South of Range 38 East and move
the Court to dismiss said petition for the reason
that to annul said road until other County roads
are established in the vicinity would be
detrimental to the interest of the Public.
After consideration the Court being satisfied
that said road ought not to be annulled at this time
It is hereby ordered that the motion herein be
