road near Crowell, and said petition laid
over until the next regular term of this
Court.

On this day came A. J.
Hughes who presents to the Court the petition
of himself and more than twelve others
praying ^{for change of a County road the} location and establishment
of ^{to be} County road as follows, to wit:
Commencing at or near the N.W. Corner of the
N.E. 1/4 of Sec 31 Town 2 South Range 38 E.
thence in a westerly direction on the line
of survey to the old mill site of W. J. Snodgrass
thence ^{so that} said road shall be described
as follows: Commencing at or near the N.W.
Corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec 31 Town 2 South Range
38 E. of the Willamette Meridian, thence North
