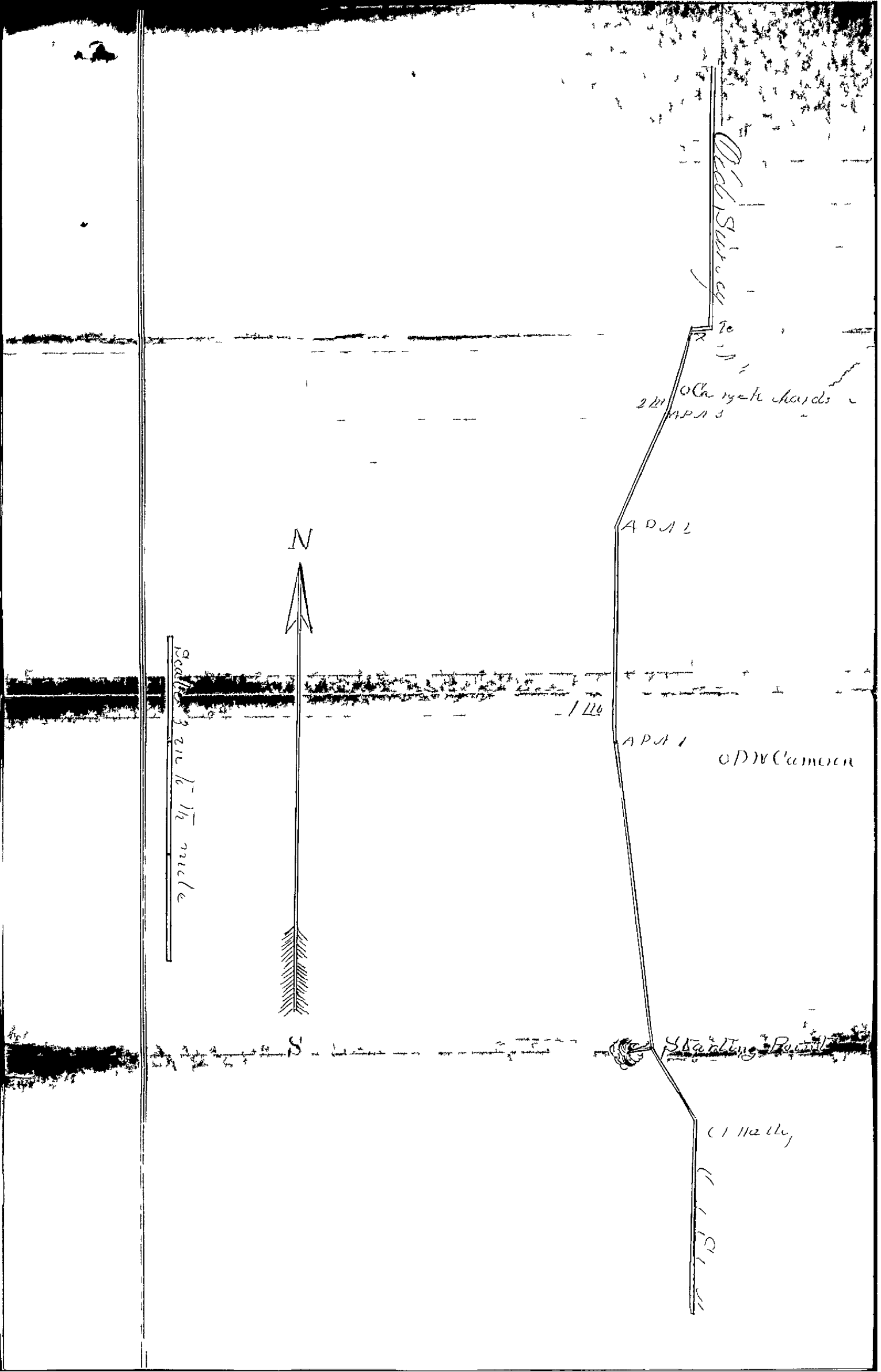

At a regular term of the County Court of Union County Oregon began and held at the Court House in La Grande Oregon On Wednesday April 8<sup>th</sup> 1868 there was present Hon J. Swerson as Judge  
 Wm J. Roger  
 E. S. McComas Clerk and A. Craig Siff

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following business was transacted

In the matter of the  
 Change in County Road

Now at this time was presented a petition duly accompanied with bond and proof of the posting of Notices in accordance with Law praying for a change to be made in a County Road beginning from La Grande to Trimble's Mill as follows to wit

" Commencing at a Small Pine Tree described  
 " as follows the said pine tree being thirteen (13)  
 " chains west of the East line of the North West  
 "  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 34 S. Range 38 E and ten chains  
 " South of the North line of the said  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec  
 " of Sec 34 from said Pine Tree to run North  
 " 70 chains angling west 7 chains thence North  
 " Sixty chains thence North Sixty chains angling  
 " East twenty chains and intersecting the above  
 " County Road " which said petition was  
 " granted and James Baker M. H. Mitchell  
 " and J. S. Hunter were appointed Viewers and  
 " J. L. Curtis Surveyor and Tuesday Apr 14<sup>th</sup> 1868  
 " was set apart as a day for viewing said road  
 " Viewers to meet at point of beginning at 10  
 " O'clock

May Term 1868

At a regular term of the County Court of Union County Oregon began and held at the Court House in La Grande Oregon on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1868 there was present S. Alberson County Judge, J. S. Morlon Commissioner, A. B. Craig Sheriff & Ed. McComas County Clerk

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following business was had

In the matter of Lic. License  
Hiram Mc Colley

Now at this time was presented a petition from Hiram Mc Colley duly accompanied with a bond and receipt from the Treasurer for the sum of Fifty Dollars which petition was granted and it was ordered that a License issue to said H. Mc Colley for the sum of six months from this date

In the matter of  
County Road

Now at this time was presented and read for the first time the Report of the Deacons in a proposed change in a County Road running from La Grande to Tombles Mill in said County

In the matter of  
Billiard License  
Matt Rice

Now at this time was presented a Receipt from the County Treasurer from Matt Rice for a Billiard License whereupon it was ordered that a Billiard License issue to Matt Rice for a term of six months from date



In the matter of Supervisor  
Road District No 11

Now at this time was appointed C. J. Keeler as Supervisor of road dist No-11 in place of E. C. Egan who it was found could not serve being a Constable

In the matter of Billiard License  
C. F. Schoppe

Now at this time was presented a receipt from the County Treasurer for the sum of Twenty Five Dollars for a Billiard License for six months whereupon it was ordered that said license issue for a term of six months from this date Court then adjourned until 9 o'clock tomorrow

2<sup>d</sup> Judicial Day Second Judicial Day Court met pursuant to adjournment some officers present

In the matter of a County  
Road from La Grange to Timble's Mill

Now at this time was presented and read for the second time the report of the viewers of a proposed change in a County road running from La Grange to Timble's Mill as follows: To this Commencing at a pine tree about 10<sup>in</sup> in diameter said tree being Thirteen (13) Chains west of the East line of the North West 1/4 of Section 34 South Range 38 East Willamette Meridian and 10 chains South of the North line of the said 1/4 Sec of Section 34 - Running from thence North by 7° West 75 Chains to angle Post No 1 thence due North 5 Chains to the One mile post Set with a large Pine tree standing angle Post No 1 bearing South by 8° West distant 5 Chains 15 Sols thence due North 17 chs to angle Post No 3 thence North by 10° East 4 chs to the 2 mile post said Post being a pine tree about 15 in in diameter standing at the side of the line of Survey thence north by 15° East 16 chs to angle Post No 4 thence East by 5° North 4 chs to the terminus of proposed change Set stake with the witness line of the land Survey bearing North by 40° East 5 chains
