Fourth Judicial Day Saturday Jan. 6<sup>th</sup>. 1883

Court met according to adjournment, same officers present as on yesterday. -

Due proclamation of the opening of court having been made, the journal of yesterday's proceedings was read and approved and are now signed.

Whereupon the following proceedings were had, to wit: -

In the matter of appropriation  
to Pine Valley & Browns Ferry  
Road -

Now at this time comes Robert Brown and petitions the court for an appropriation to assist in constructing the road from Pine Valley to Browns Ferry in this county - and at the same time presents to the court the subscription list of citizens of this county, pledging the sum of \$2,048<sup>00</sup> to assist in the building and completion of said road -

And it appearing to the court that the interests of Union County and all concerned would be promoted by the completion of said road - It is therefore ordered that the sum of \$750<sup>00</sup> be appropriated out of the county fund for the building and completion of said Road - Provided however that no "warrant" shall be issued for the payment of said appropriation or any portion thereof until an amount proportionate thereto shall have been actually applied from the work <sup>or money</sup> subscribed to said road and the certificate of the superintendent of said work or appropriation shall be filed with this court that said work has been so applied - And it is further ordered that James Summers he and he is hereby appointed superintendent of said appropriation, and that he duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of his duties herein -

Third Judicial Day Friday Nov-6-1885-  
 District No. 16 - proceed forthwith to clear  
 said road of all obstructions and keep  
 the same clear when notified or having  
 knowledge of its being obstructed.

Thereupon court adjourned till tomorrow  
 morning at nine o'clock

Fourth Judicial Day Saturday Nov-7-1885-

Court met pursuant to adjournment present  
 the same judge and Commissioners and  
~~officers~~ as all yesterday.

 on the Pine Valley and Brown Lee ferry wagon  
 road said R. Brown presenting and filing  
 three receipts made to him for money paid  
 out by him on said road and it  
 appearing to the satisfaction of the court  
 that only a sufficient amount of money  
 has been paid in on subscriptions to said

to justify the County in allowing the sum of \$150- on said appropriation. It is there fore ordered by the Court that the clerk of this Court issue to said R. Brown the sum of \$150- in County warrants on the appropriation of \$450- heretofore made by this Court for said road,

In the matter of making  
an investigation and  
exhibit of the financial  
condition of Union County }  
Oregon }

Now at this  
time James J. Outhouse who was hereto-  
fore appointed by the Court to investigate  
and ascertain the financial condition  
of Union County - and file his report  
and after a careful examination of  
the same by the Court and finding  
the same in all respects to con-  
form to the former order of this Court  
and that said report contains a full  
and true statement of all matters relative  
to the financial standing of this County  
and it further appearing that said J.  
J. Outhouse has fully discharged all  
the duties which devolved upon him in this  
matter and is entitled to be discharged It is  
therefore ordered by the Court that said report  
be and the same is hereby accepted and  
J. J. Outhouse discharged from further duties  
in this matter. And it is further ordered  
that said report be published in full in  
the Mountain Sentinel for one issue and  
that said newspaper publish no less than  
one thousand copies and distribute the same  
in this County and that said report be  
not printed in any paper sent out of  
this County.
