thence on the Union Town road, East to the
South East corner of said Briggs field, thence
on the best and nearest ground until
intersect the old ^{road} or near the foot of
said ~~mill~~. We the undersigned undertake, to pay
all expenses accruing on the procuring
and surveying and returning the report of
same, attending such Change

Liquor License to
John Sword

Now on this day was presented a petition for a liquor license from John Sword praying for a license to sell spirituous liquors in less quantities than one quart in each precinct in Union County which petition was accompanied by a bond and notice duly accompanied by Certificate of an officer duly authorized and also by a receipt from the County Treasurer for the sum of fifty dollars whereupon it was ordered that a license issue to said John Sword for a term of six months from this date

In the Matter of
County Road } Now at this time was presented a petition praying for the appointment of Viewers to view a County Road as follows to wit Commencing at the House of E. Briggs thence follow the road East to the S. E. Cor. of said Briggs field thence in a S. E. Course on the best and nearest ground and entered the old road at the foot of Ladd Hill" which said petition being duly accompanied by an affidavit of proof of the posting of notices in accordance with law which petition was granted and Joseph Jones, Jackson Kearns and J. D. Andrews were appointed as Viewers and J. L. Curtis Surveyor to meet at point of beginning on Sat June 13th 1868 at ten o'clock AM.
