by R. J. Rogers et al

Now at this time is presented to the Court the petition of R. J. Rogers et al praying for the location of a County Road as follows to wit: Commencing at a point known as the Catharine Creek Bridge at or near the S. E. corner of section 21 T. 3 S. R. 39 East, and running thence due west on the section line 4 miles in Union County, State of Oregon. It satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof herein filed that due and legal notice had been given of the pendency of the proceeding, as required by law, that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders living in the vicinity of said proposed County Road and that a good and sufficient Bond has been filed herein. Therefore the Court orders and adjudges that S. R. Bloom, Bob Shaw and John Boyd be appointed viewers and two disinterested Surveyors, to view, survey and report upon said proposed County Road and that they meet at the Catharine Creek Bridge on the 15th day of July 1884 at 9 o'clock A.M. and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

that - the center of said river is the boundary line between this and Baker Counties and that - one half of said bridge should be built at the expense of said Baker County and it further appearing to the Court that said bridge should be rebuilt. And ^{it is therefore} ~~and~~ the order by the Court that the same viewers be notified to view out and locate said proposed road under their former appointments - and that Moses Austin be ~~also~~ is hereby appointed surveyor to survey said road. And further that - they meet at the farm of Willis Skiff on Sept. 19 - 1854 at 10 o'clock and duly qualify before entering in the discharge of their duties in this behalf.
