In the matter of constructing
a Bridge across Eagle
Creek.

To the Hon the County Court
of Union County State of Oregon
We your Petitioners and citizens
of Eagle Valley and Precinct would
most respectfully represent to the
Court that there is need of a Bridge
across Eagle Creek on the Road
leading from the School house to
the Pine Creek Road - that there
a number of citizens living on
either side of said creek - that said
Creek at the crossing of said Road
is not Passable or fordable
a portion of the year during high
water that in consequence of which
the said citizens are compelled to
travel a long distance to cross
said creek - the School children being
compelled to travel 8 or 9 miles
further on account of the absence
of said Bridge
wherefore we would most respect-
fully ask the Court to construct
a Bridge of suitable dimensions

across said creek at the crossing
designated above of which you
Petitioners will ever pray -
Date at Eagle Valley this 31st day
May 1854

Now at this time is presented
to the Court the petition of P. J. Brown and twenty seven
others to build a County Bridge across Eagle Creek
on the County Road leading from the school house
to the Pine Creek County Road, and it appearing to the
Court from the petition herein filed that said bridge
is necessary for the convenience of the public it
is hereby ordered that the Supervisor of the Road
District in which said bridge is to be built is hereby
authorized to purchase the necessary
covering and spikes to complete said bridge upon
the District or people interested ^{at their own expense} furnish the necessary
timbers and abutments for a good and substantial
bridge ready for the covering.
