Signed this 30<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1883.

Now the condition of the above obligation is such that whereas if the County Road petitioners for by Bruce Evans and others and presented at the July term 1883 of the County Court of said Union County, commencing at a point past 25 miles from the town of Joseph on the Joseph and Pine Creek County road and terminating at Mouth of Devils Gulch in Union County Oregon, be located and established then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law.
