In the matter of County
Roads petitioned for by
T. B. Day, et al, who
presented at the January
term of the County Court
1886.

Comes now the under-
signed, resident householders and
legal voters, residing along the line
of and in the immediate vicinity of
the Proposed County Road petitioned for
and presented at this (January) term
of the Hon County Court by T. B. Day,
H. H. Hinters et al, asking that a
County road be granted located and
established on the following Route
Commencing at the North East corner
of section ^{six} (6) Twp 3 South Range No 46
Ewm. thence running west on the
base line to the north West corner of the
North East quarter of section No. 3
Twp 3 South of Range No 45 Ewm
and there terminating, and ^{and Protest} Respectfully
Remonstrate against the above proposed
road being granted, located or establis-
hed for the following Reasons:

1"

That there is a County Road

within the distance of three fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$)
mile north of the proposed road and
running parallel with said proposed
road.

2"

That there is a County road commen-
cing at the terminus of said proposed
road (N W corner of the NE quarter of
Sec 3 Twp 3 South R 45 Ewm.) and
running south $\frac{1}{2}$ mile thence East
one mile parallel with proposed road
thence and at that point intersecting a
Cross County road running North and
South extending each way for many
miles. Then east of this road $\frac{1}{2}$
mile is another County road running
north and south and extending for
many miles each way

3"

That there is evidently no reason
why said proposed road should be granted
as the neighborhood is well supplied with
roads already and said road cannot
be opened without great inconvenience
and damage to the settlers.

4"

That the petitioners asking for the
above proposed road has not complied
with the law regulating road petitions
in this; that the signature of H. H.
Hinters, is not genuine for the

in this; that the signature of W. H. Winters, is not genuine for the

reason that it is a notorious fact that W. H. Winters has not been in this part of the country since early last spring, also that the names of J. C. Redman, John Kumble, J. D. Hasbrouk and Wm. Burrap and ^{S. Pierce} are not residents of the vicinity of the proposed road they are living at distances ranging from 2 to 20 miles from said proposed road.

5 Said petition fails to mention any distances of said road.

6 That said petition does not reveal where said road is to be located whether in Union County or District of Columbia.
