House of A. G. Brathan 235 Rods. Then in a South
Eastward direction on the most practicable Route about 123
Rods, to a point near the House of Henry Bacon. Then in a

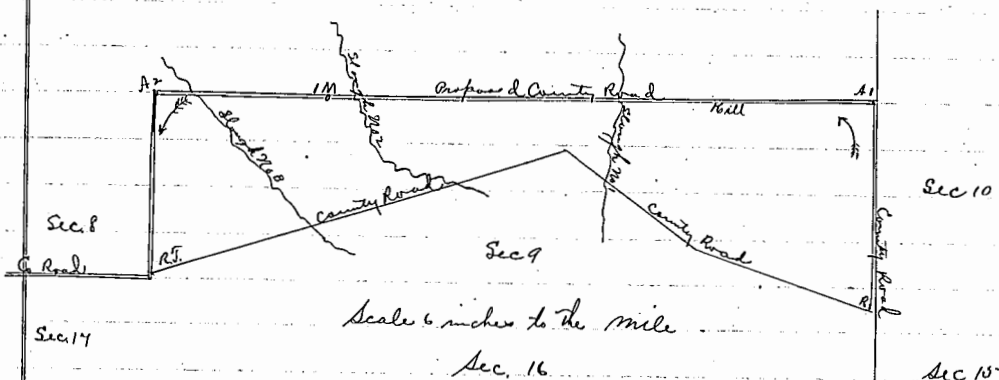
