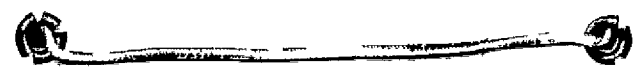

by Charles Goodnough & others

Now at this time comes Charles Goodnough and presents to the Court the petition of himself and 23 others praying for the establishment of a County road described as follows, to wit; Beginning on the County road at the S. E. corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 2, T. 3. S. R. 38. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ thence running west $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to the SW corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, thence north $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the County road leading east from Island City Oregon. Also to vacate a portion of the County road Beginning at the N. E. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2. Thence running west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the N. W. corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ section 2. T. 3. S. R. 38. SW $\frac{1}{4}$. And it appearing to the Court that more than 12 of said Petitioners are legal householders of Union County living in the vicinity of said proposed road, and proof having been filed herein from which it appears that legal notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given and a good and sufficient undertaking having been filed herein as provided by law, and a so called remonstrance against said petition having been

filed herein, which remonstrance having been duly considered by the Court, the Court struck therefrom the names of certain of the remonstrators known to the Court as not having the necessary qualifications either to petition or remonstrate herein, thus leaving the number of remonstrators less than the number of petitioners, the Court further finds that said so called remonstrance gives no description of the road remonstrated against. It is ordered by the Court that no attention be paid to said so called remonstrance and it further appearing to the Court that no good cause has been shown why such road should not be surveyed It is now here considered and ordered by the Court that John J. Peetler, Ed. Mulholland and Ben Brown be appointed Viewers and Moses Austin Surveyor, to view, survey and report upon said proposed County road, and that they meet at the store of the Island City W & M. Company in Island City on the 22^d day of March AD 1888 at 10 o'clock A. M., and that they duly qualify according to law, before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

Sanger Precinct.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the petition of Fred. Duncan and others praying the Court to establish the Precinct of Sanger in Union County according to the boundaries hereinafter set forth and it appearing to the Court that it would be for the convenience of the legal voters resident within said boundaries that said Precinct should be established It is therefore considered and ordered by the Court that the Territory embraced in the following boundaries, to wit; Commencing at the N.W. corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec 3. T. 6 S. R. 42 E. 10 W., thence South to the S. W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec 15 T. 7. S. R. 42 E. 10 W. thence West to the S. E. corner of the S. 1/4 Sec 17. T. 7. S. R. 44 E. 10 W. thence North to the N. E. corner of the N. 1/4 Sec 5 T. 6. S. R. 44. E. 10 W. thence West to the N. W. cor of the N. W. 1/4 Sec 3 T. 6. S. R. 42 E. 10 W. the place of beginning be and the same is hereby established as an Election Precinct of Union County, Oregon and shall be designated and known as Sanger Precinct.

Thereupon the Court adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock
