TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

Near Angle Stake for 208 near the S W corner of the N W 1/4 of the N W 1/4 of Sec. 12 T. 3 S. R. 36 E. Run thence West passing north up Spring Creek to a point near S W corner of the N E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of Sec. 33 T. 2 S. R. 36 E. Run thence North to a point on Spring Creek near the S E corner of the N E 1/4 of Sec. 21 T. 2 S. R. 36 E. Run
