At a Regular Term of the County Court of Union County State of Oregon began and held at the Court House in LeGrand Oregon on the 3rd day of July A.D. 1871 there was present Hon. E. C. Brainerd County Judge A. C. Smith County Commissioner Arthur Warrick Sheriff and J. M. Black County Clerk

Due Proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following Business was transacted

In the Matter of Petition
of County Road from
H. Shoemaker to Summerville

Now at this time was presented a petition asking for a County Road to be established from the Residence of Fred Shoemaker to the Town of Summerville and said Petition having the requisite number of Resident Householders residing in the Vicinity of said Road as signers thereto and proof of notices having been posted according to law having been made and filed also a Bond having been filed which Bond was duly accepted by the Court. Said petition was read in Open Court for the first time, and laid over for further action until Thursday the 6th day of July 1871

Court then adjourned until Thursday July the 6th 1871 at Eight O'clock A.M.

the Court that twelve resident house-
holders residing in the vicinity and along
the line of the said Road and proof
of notices having been duly posted according
to law, and a Bond filed in accordance
with law which Bond was duly accepted
and approved, The following persons
were appointed as Viewers, to wit:
Henry Myers Arthur Hemming and C. A.
Gillham, and J. G. Leuter's Surveyor
who are to meet at the House of Frederick
Shoemaker on the 24th day of July 1871
and proceed to mark out said Road and
report their proceedings at the next Term of
this Court

Now at this term was presented Viewers Report together with the Field notes and plat of Survey of a County Road, commencing at the residence of Frederick Shoemaker in Union County and terminating at the Town of Summerville in said County heretofore appointed, which Report set forth that the route was practicable and of general benefit to the Citizens of said County.

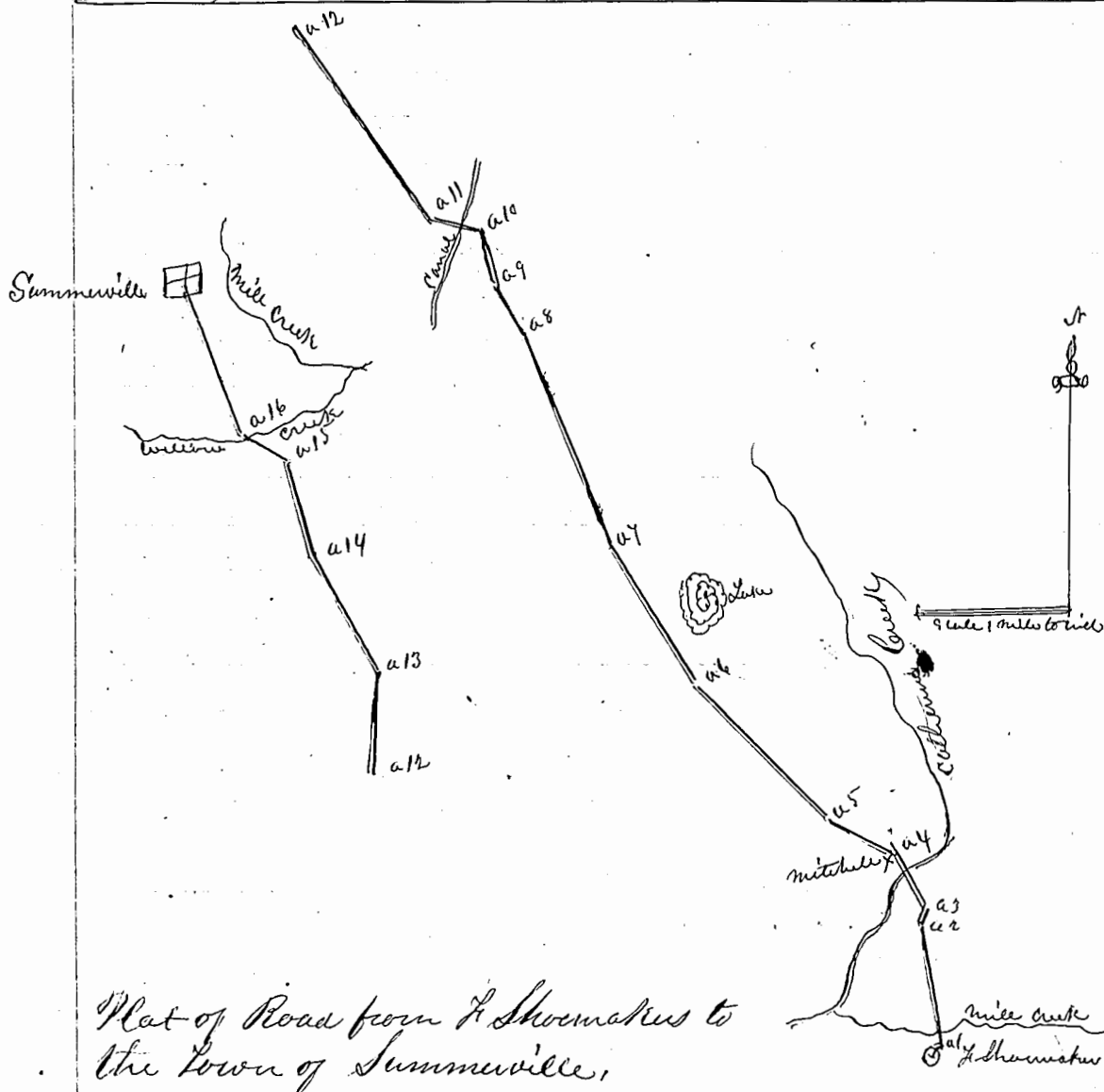
The following are the field notes of the Survey of said Road as reported by J. L. Curtis Surveyor appointed heretofore under the direction of said Viewers

Commencing at a rock in front of H. Shoemaker thence N by 55° E 4 Chs to angle 1 thence N by 8° W 76 Chs to a 2 thence N by 21° E 10 Chs. to a 3 thence N by 20° W 40 Chs. to a 4 thence N by 59° W 50 Chs. to a 5 thence N by 50° W 115 Chs. to a 6 thence N by 27° W 95 Chs. to a 7 thence N by 20° W 145 Chs. to a 8 thence N by 25° W 30 Chs. to a 9 thence N by 13° W 34 Chs. to a 10. thence N by 75° W 30 Chs. to a 11. thence N by 32° W 251 Chs. to a 12. thence North 60 Chs to a 13 thence N by 30° W 90 Chs to a 14 thence N by 17° W 60 Chs. to a 15 thence N by 56° W 30 Chs to a 16. thence N by 24° W 100 Chs. to the terminus of the Road making the distance 15 1/4 miles in all.
