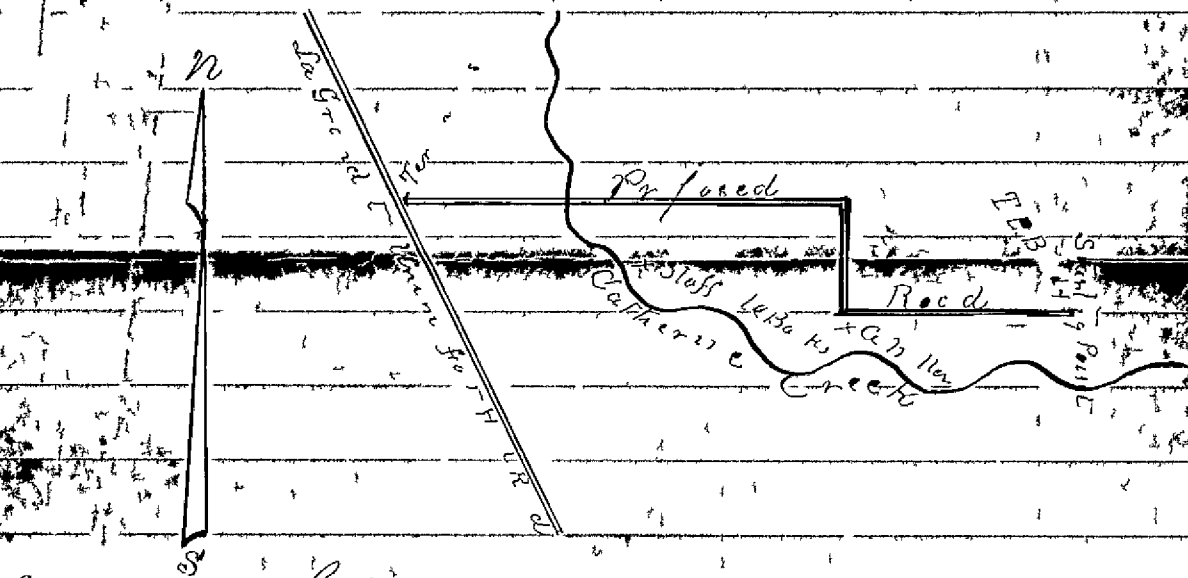
Revenue Reports

To the Honorable County Court
of Union Co Oregon

We the undersigned citizens of Union County
would represent to your Honorable body that
heretofore and up to this time it has been utterly
impossible at certain seasons of of the year for the
inhabitants an the traveling public to pass from one
section of the valley to the other or to the county seat
on account of insufficient public roads and Bridges
and that the time has now arrived from the increase
of population wealth and importance of the settlements
in this valley that at least one main thoroughfare
should be opened so that travel shall be uninterrupted
at all seasons of the year We therefore ask that you
appropriate an amount necessary as required by law
to build a Bridge across Grande Ronde River
on the road leading from Summerville and Union
by the way of Shoemaker's point and to appropriate
such further sum for said road as your Judgment
may deem proper and your petitioners will ever
pray

In the Matter of a proposed
County Road in Union County

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for the location of a County road, which petition was signed by more than twelve resident householders residing in the vicinity and along the line of said proposed Road, which petition was accompanied with a Bond as the law requires in favor of Union County, which Bond was approved by the Court, and also with proof of Notices having been posted more than thirty days prior to the first day of this term of Court, commencing at the County Road in Union precinct at or near the House of Thomas P Baird and running westerly one mile, thence North one half mile, (thence North one half) mile, thence westerly one and one half mile to intersect the County Road leading from Union to Salpand all of which points and places are in Union County Oregon

It is therefore Ordered that Charles McClure, John Russell and Adam Gorge be and they are hereby appointed Viewers to view, set out and mark said proposed Road and J. L. Curtis is hereby appointed Surveyor of the same who are to meet at the House of Clark & Newhard on the 26th day of March 1872 and report their proceedings at the May term of this Court,

Now at this time was submitted the Report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view, mark and locate a County Road commencing at the north end of Proctitels Lane and intersecting the Road from Salpand to Summerville, which Report was accompanied by a plat and field notes of J. L.

In the Matter of Viewers
Report to assess Damages

Now at this time the Viewers heretofore appointed to assess damages if any that Frederick Mitchell and H. A. Mitchell would sustain by reason of a County road running through their lands which report allowed H. Mitchell the sum of \$224, and H. A. Mitchell the sum of \$112. Making in the aggregate the sum of \$336. And the Court deeming said road not of sufficient importance to the public for County to pay the damages the Court therefore refuse to establish said road unless the petitioners shall pay the expenses and damages thereof,

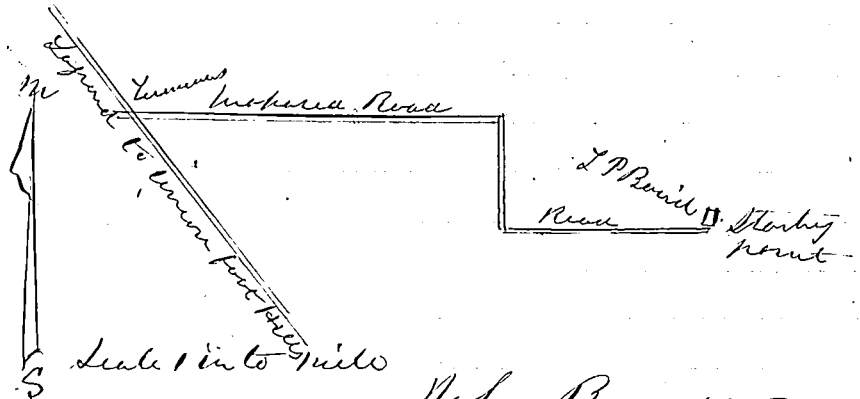
In the Matter of
Viewers Report

Now at this time was presented the report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view a road commencing near the house of T. P. Baird in Union County, Oregon and terminating on the foot Hill Road from Galbraith to Union which report stated that they met on the 26th day of March 1872 and after being duly sworn proceeded to view and locate said road with J. L. Curtis as Surveyor, and located said road as the following field notes and plat of the Surveyor, and further that they believe the same to be of practical benefit for a highway.

It is therefore ordered that the said road as shown by the following plat and field notes of said Surveyor herein after recorded be and the same is hereby declared a public highway, and that Supervisors are hereby ordered to open and keep the same in repair as other County roads are opened and kept in repair.

Comes L B. Reinbolt County Treasurer of Union
County Oregon and returned to this Court the
Sum of Eight Hundred and Seventy two $\frac{65}{100}$
