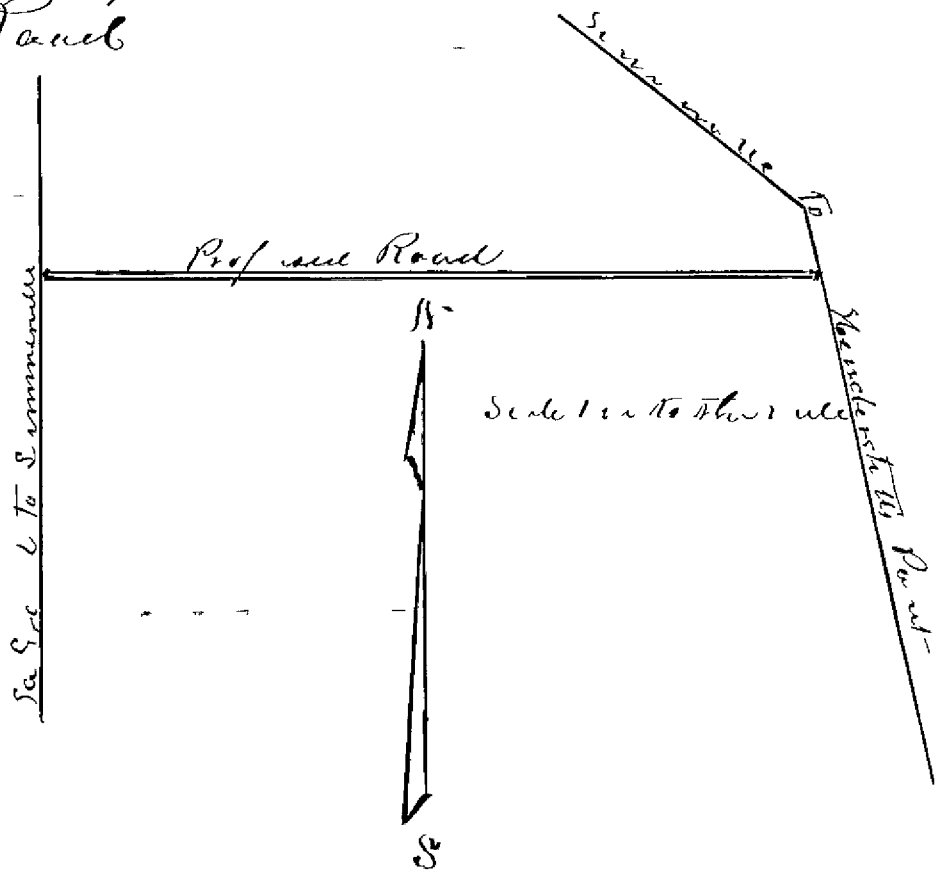

1872 with J. S. Curtis as Surveyor and
after being first duly sworn proceeded
to view out and locate said Road
and further that we believe the route
to be practicable and of general benefit
to the Citizens residing in the vicinity
of said Road all of which is
respectfully submitted together with
the Plat and Note of the Survey

At a regular term of the County Court of Union County State of Oregon began and held at the Court House in Galpade Oregon on the sixth day of May A D 1872 There were present Hon E C Mainard County Judge A C Smith and B H Lewis County Commissioners Arthur Wannick Sheriff and J M Black County Clerk.

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following Business was transacted,

In the Matter of Road 3
Petition for Co Road 3

Now on this day was read first time a petition praying for the location of a County Road commencing at the County Road leading from Summerville to Galpade where the Section line between Sections 27 and 34 in Township one South of Range thirty nine East crosses said Road, thence due East on Section line to intersect the County Road from Summerville to Hendawhatts point, and proof of posting of notices according to law having been made as well as a good and sufficient Bond having been filed, The Consideration of which was laid over until tomorrow.

Court then adjourned until tomorrow at 9 O'clock.

In the Matter of Painting
the Court House in the
inside

Now at this time it
appearing that the inside of the Court House
needed to be painted, and Ben Bowman
having offered to paint the same with three
coats for the Bar ceiling and inside thereof
and one heavy coat on the Ballance of the
inside of the Court Room for the sum of three
dollars per square, It is therefore ordered
that the same be allowed, and agreed upon
to pay said Ben Bowman the sum of three
dollars per square when completed in a workman
like order

In the Matter of Road
Petitions from line between
Sec 27 & 34 T 1 S R 39 & 40

Now on this day comes
on for hearing the petition read only yesterday
praying for the location of a County Road Com-
mencing at the County road leading from Sum-
merville to Goltrand where the Section line
between Sec 27 & 34 T 1 S R 39 & 40, thence East on
Sec line to intersect Road from Summerville
to Hendricks Point, and it appearing to
the Court that said petition did not show
that said petitioners were householders residing
on the route or vicinity of said proposed road
said being not in accordance with law it
is hereby rejected and the prayer of petitioners
is not granted

In the Matter of Road
Petitions

Now at this time: was pre-
sented a petition of J Swell and twelve other
citizens and householders of Union County Oregon
residing in the vicinity of the following proposed
road. Commencing at the County Road leading
from Summerville to Galgande, at the point
where the section line between section 27 and 34
Township 1 South Range 38 East crosses said
Road running East and West; Thence on said
section line East till it intersects the County
Road leading from Summerville to Hendersons
Point, all of which points and places are in Union
County Oregon. Which petition was accompanied
with proof of Notices having been posted as
by law required also with a Bond in accordance
with law. It is therefore ordered that Joshua
Hooper W R Booth and Wash Bloom be and they
are hereby appointed Viewers, and J L Curtis
Surveyor who are to meet at the house of Wm Woodells
on first Monday in August 1872 and after being

duly qualified proceed to view out said proposed road and report at the next term of this Court.

Court then adjourned until tomorrow at 8 O'clock A.M.

make return of Roll

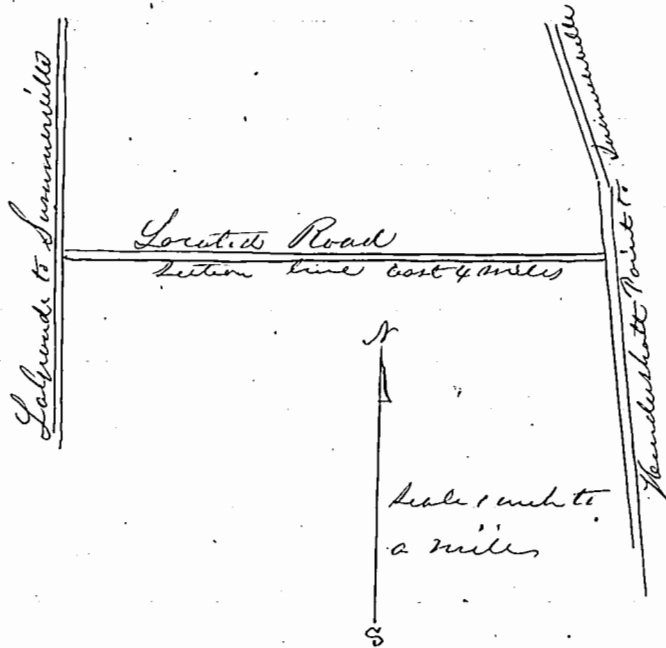
Now at this time A. B. Craig made application for further time to return his Assessment Roll. It is therefore Ordered that the Assessor have until the 16th day of September 1872 to complete the Assessment Roll.

In the Matter of Road
Report of Viewers

Now at this time was submitted the Viewers Report together with the plat and filed notes of a County Road commencing at the County Road leading from Galpanda to Sumnerville where the Section line between Section 27 and 34 in Township 1 South of Range 38 East crosses said Road thence due East to intersect the Road from Hoendershatts Point to Sumnerville. And the said Viewers heretofore appointed having reported the route according to the following plat of the Survey to be practicable and of general utility to the Citizens

It is therefore Ordered that the same be declared a public highway, in accordance with the following plat & filed notes, and

that the same be opened and kept in repair as other County Roads, and Supervisors are authorized to open the same



In the Matter of Sheriff's }
 Additional Bond } 3

Now at this time comes Arthur Wainick Sheriff and files an additional Bond in the sum of Five thousand Dollars as Tax collector of Union County, which Bond was duly approved by the Court and Ordered placed on file

In the Matter of Pedlars }
 Licenses } 3

Now at this time it is Ordered that Pedlars shall pay into the County Treasury the sum of three ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for Licenses to peddle Merchandise in said County with wagons for each week, and without team the sum of one dollar & fifty cents per week, and for one month with team the sum of ten dollars, and without team per month the sum of five dollars,
