I am contemplating opening county road for which petition notices are posted beginning of said road at a point Sixty (60) rods east of the South West corner of the North West quarter (14) of the south west quarter (14) of Section Fourteen (14) Township Three (3) south of Range Forty (40) east of the Willimette Meridian, Forty (40) feet wide running thence north I will ask damages as follows:

For strip of land 20 feet wide and 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods long about 1/2 acre.	\$150.00
Re setting twenty young fruit trees	50
25 rods fence.	200
If any or all of above fruit trees are killed by replanting I ask for one dollar each if not I ask for no damage to trees.	
Total	\$1750

I feel friendly to opening of the road only asking actual expense to me if opened.

Petition for County Road.

To the Honorable County Court, For Union County, Oregon.

The undersigned householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said County, on the following line or route, to-wit:

Beginning at a point about 60 rods east of the Northwest corner of the SW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of sec 14 in T³S. R⁴0E. 7th. Beginning there northwesterly about 3/4 of a mile to the section line between sections 11 + 14 - same township. Thence running Easterly on the said section line to a point about 20 rods west of the section corner between sections 11, 12, 13 + 14 of said township. Thence angling southeasterly to a point about 10 rods on the section line running north and south between said sections 12 + 13 about 10 rods south of the Northwest corner of said sec 13. Thence southerly on the said section line to a point 40 rods south of section corner between sections 11, 12, 13 + 14, thence Easterly one half mile and there terminating. Said road to be 20 feet wide.

And in duty bound your petitioners will ever pray, &c.

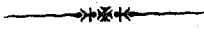
