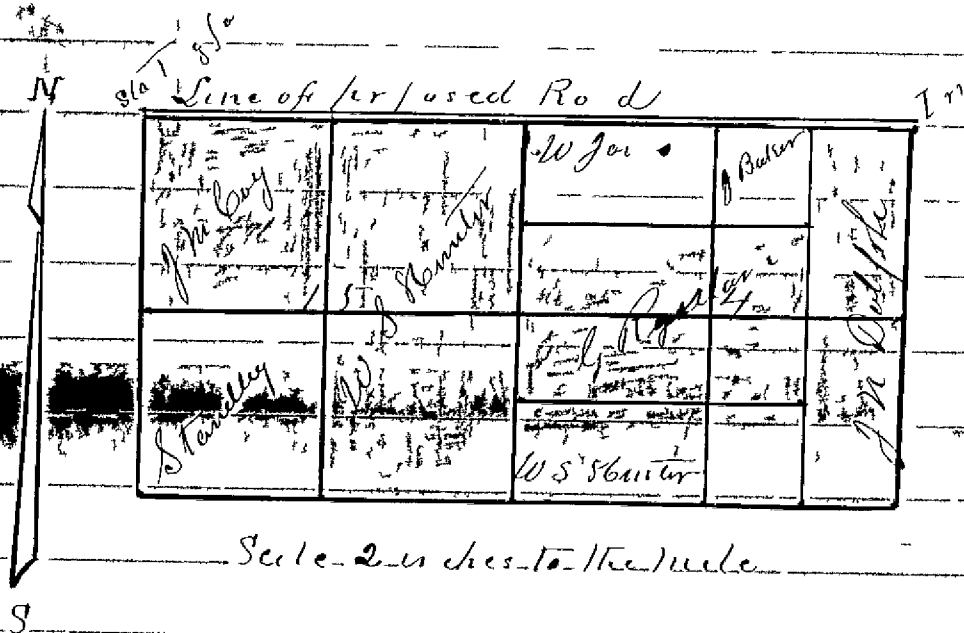

approved by the Court, also with proof of notices having been posted according to law

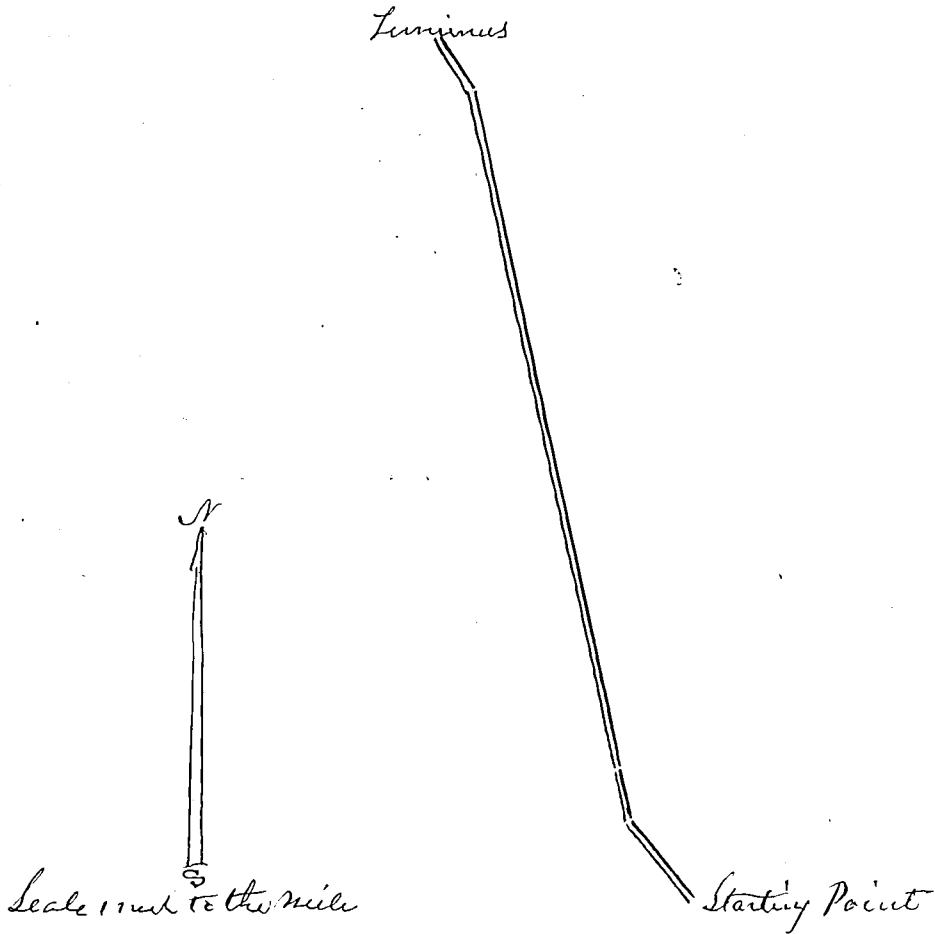
It was thereupon Ordered that Joseph Muesner Joshua Hoopfer and P A Mahaffy be and they are hereby appointed Viewers and J S Curtis Surveyor, who are to meet on the 15th day of November 1873 to view out and mark said route, and report their doings at the next term of this Court with a plat and Survey of the same,

In the Matter of Road }
Petition in Union Co. }

Now on this day was presented a petition signed by more than twelve residents householders residing in the vicinity and along the route of the hereinafter proposed route praying for the location of a County road in Union County as follows to wit:

Commencing at the County Road near Hollgarth's Ranch, thence along the base of the Mountain through Sections 21-10-9 and 8 Township one North of Range 39 East to Gordon Creek, thence continuing along the Sinkton road to the boundary line or junction of Union and Amatitlee counties, all of which points and places are in Union County Oregon Which petition was duly accompanied with a bond which bond was duly approved by the Court, also by proof of notices having been posted in accordance with the law It was thereupon Ordered that Isaac Long Joel Weaver and John White be and are hereby appointed Viewers, and J. S. Curtis, Surveyor to view out and mark said route, who are to meet at the House of Seb. Hollgarth's on the 22^d day of November 1873 and after qualifying to proceed to view the

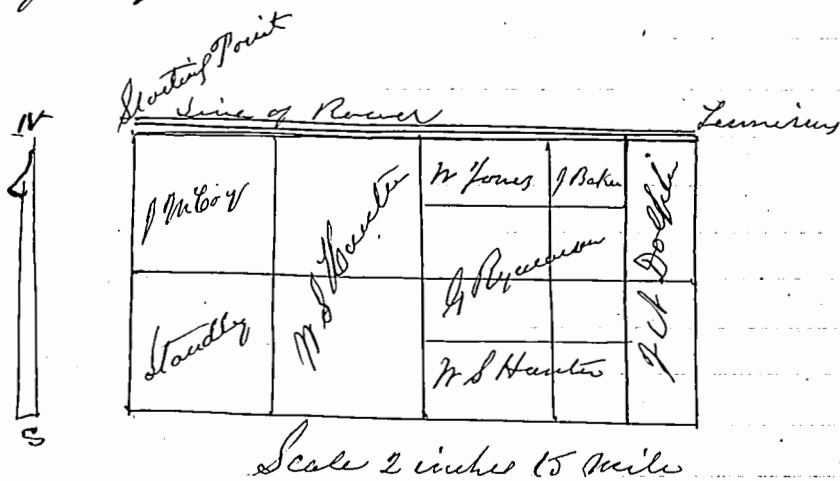

Now on this day came on to be heard the Report of the Viewers heretofore appointed upon its second reading for the location of a county road commencing at the NN corner of Section 15 Township Two South Range 38 East and running thence due East two miles to the North East corner of Section Fourteen Township 2 South of Range 38 East, which report was accompanied with the plat and field notes of the survey as made by J S Curtis heretofore appointed, the Viewers having reported favorable

And it appearing that the Petitioners had in all things complied with the law by filing Bond proof of notices having been posted in accordance with law, and the Petitions having been signed by more than twelve residents householders living in the vicinity and along the route of said County Road, and it further appearing that all the points and places were in Union County Oregon
