To The Honorable County Court of Union County State of Oregon, The undersigned - 19 - Resident House holders and others living on the a-bine and in the immediate vicinity of the hereinafter described Road would respectfully represent to your honorable body that "County Road leading from Cove to Big Creek near High Valley would much better accommodate the travelling public by making the following Change ~~Change~~ in said road ~~etc~~ the ground over which the road passes now is, very and impassable for several months in the year - that on which it is proposed to be changed is firm and good the whole year, while there is no perceptible difference in the distance

Change of Road to ~~leave~~

The old Road at or near angle post No 16 at the North end of High Valley and passing on the East side instead of the West of the Wilkinson farm and intersecting the old Road at or near the 6 mile post on said road. All of which points and places are in Union County State of Oregon.

Your petitioners would earnestly request that you send out Viewers to examine and report on said Change.

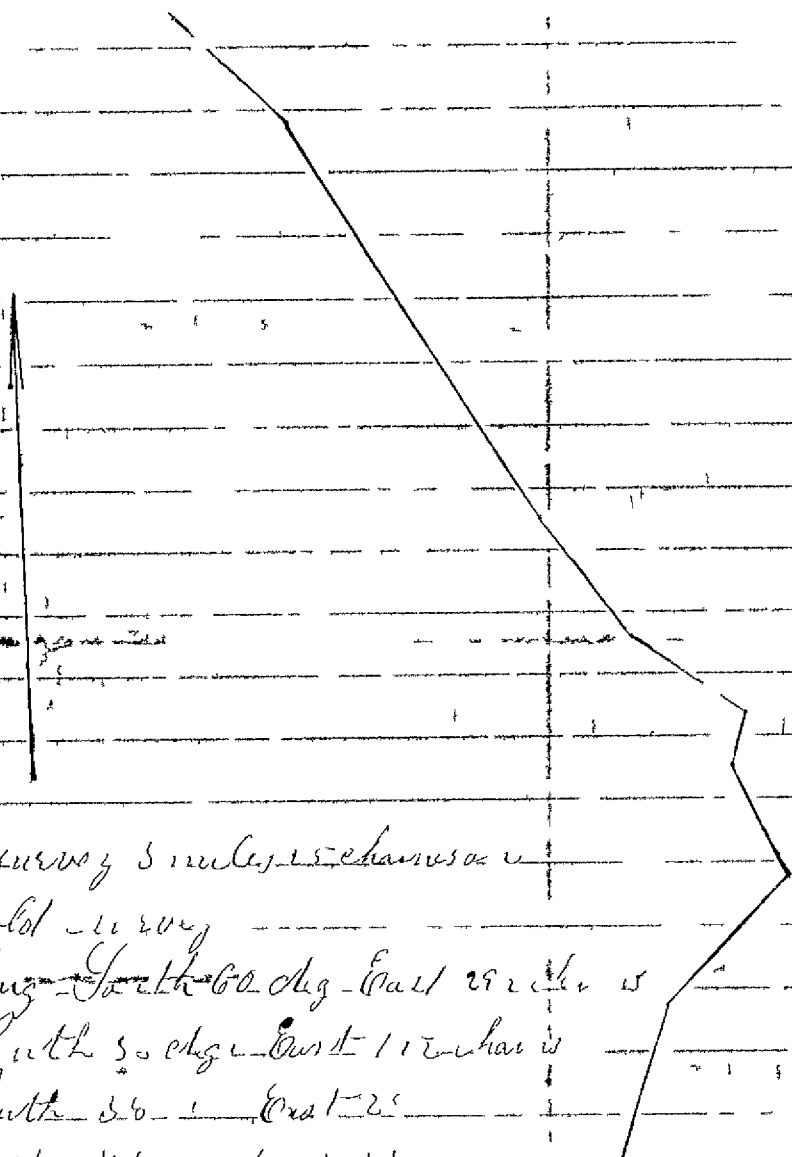


To the County Court of

At a Term of the County Court of the State of Oregon for Union County began and held at the Court House in La Grande pursuant to adjournment on Monday the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1874. Then were present, Hon. E. C. Brainerd County Judge, John A. Childers and J. H. Kennedy County Commissioners. Arthur Harwick, Sheriff and S. M. Black County Clerk.

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had

In the Matter of Road }  
Petition for Change of Route }

Now on this day was presented a petition praying for a change to be made in the County road leading from the Cove to Big Creek via High Valley, commencing at or near angle post No 10 at the North end of High Valley, and passing on the East Side instead of the West Side of the Wilkinson farm, and intersecting the Old Road at or near the 6 mile post on said road, all of which points and places are in Union County Oregon, which petition was duly accompanied by a bond, as well as by proof of notices having been posted in according to law, and said petition having been signed by more than twelve resident householders residing along the route of said proposed Road

It is therefore Ordered that Andy Wilkinson Nathaniel Sedgiz and Warden Hathaway be and they are hereby appointed Deviders, and Willis Skiff Surveyor who are to meet at the House of Jacob Wilkinson on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1874 at 9 O'clock a.m. and report their doings at next term of this court.

accompanied by a bond which Bond was approved by the Court, also with proof of notices having been posted according to law more than thirty days prior to this date.

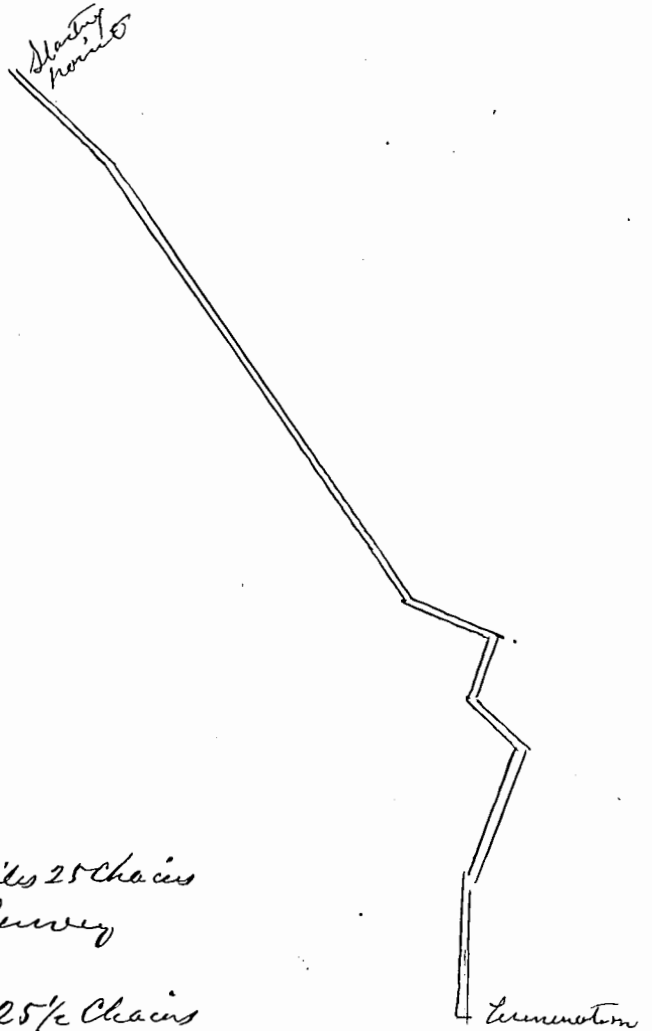
It is therefore Ordered that J. S. Hunter Wm Moss and W W Woodell be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Willis Skiff Surveyor, who are to meet at the house of E S Nevils on the 29 day of May 1874 and after being duly sworn to proceed to view out and mark said proposed road and report their proceedings to the next term of this Court.

In the Matter of Road  
Viewers Report

Now on this day was read for the second time the Report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view an alteration in the Road from Big Creek to the Cove, commencing at angle 10 on said road and terminating at the Six Mile post. Which report stated that that the distance was increased about  $24\frac{1}{2}$  Chains but is located on a much better ground and recommending that said change be made as of public utility.

And after due Considerations had  
It is Ordered that said Alterations be made in said Road in accordance with the Surveyors plat and field notes hereinafter entered & plat accompanying the same, be and the same is hereby declared to be a public Highway, and Ordered opened and kept in Repair as other public Roads, And further that all that part of said road between the points of starting and termination of said alteration be vacated and annulled
