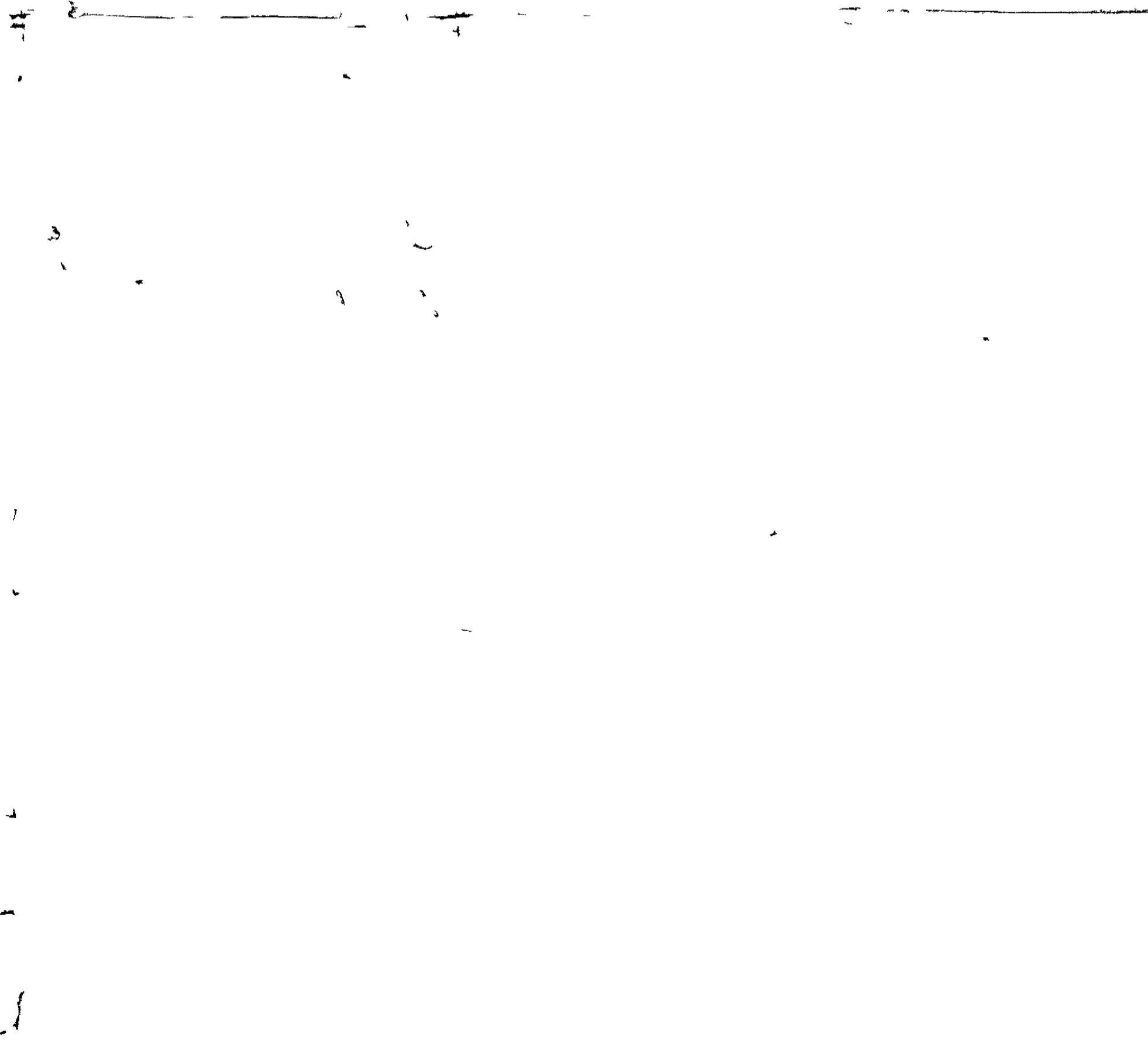

I hereby certify that I have in the
 direction of the viewers appointed by the
 County Court of Union County to lay out a
 county road from the county road at the North
 east corner of C. H. Lewis' farm one half mile
 North of the Town of Union thence running West
~~one fourth of a mile to the township line thence on~~
 the best and most direct line practicable to the
 bridge crossing Grande Ronde River at the
 Town of Ordel surveyed and established
 posts & monuments as follows: Commencing at North
 East corner of C. H. Lewis' farm and running West
 one quarter of a mile or (80) eighty rods to the township
 line thence North (240) two hundred and forty rods
 on the township line to a mile post and monument
 thence North (80) eighty rods to a quarter
 post thence North (39) thirty nine degrees West (240)
 two hundred and forty rods to the (2) two mile post
 thence North (39) thirty nine degrees West (320) three hundred
 and twenty rods to the (3) three mile post thence
 North (45½) forty five and one half degrees West (66)
 sixty six rods to the North East corner of Canolla
 farm thence North (57½) West fifty seven and one half
 degrees West (254) two hundred and fifty four rods
 to the (4) four mile post thence North (57½) fifty seven
 and a half degrees West (32) thirty two rods to a stake
 and mound thence North (22½) twenty two and a half
 degrees West (288) two hundred and eighty eight rods
 to a (5) five mile post thence North (22½) twenty two
 and a half degrees West (56) fifty six rods to a stake and
 mound at the edge of the backwater from Grande Ronde River
 on the East side of Catharine Creek thence North (30½)
 thirty and a half degrees West 264 rods to the (7) seven mile
 post.

I have to judge the distance for the last portion as the water runs
 high to no level it and not being prepared with logarithms to calculate from an angle

post on the West side of Catharine Creek Thence North
 (68) sixty eight degrees West one mile to the (8) eight
 mile post thence on the same course (N 68° W) one
 mile to the (9) nine mile post Thence on the
 same course (N 68° W) one half mile to a mound
 and stake Thence North (56 1/2) fifty six and a half
 degrees West one half mile to the (10) ten mile post
 Thence on the same course (N 56 1/2° W) one mile to the
 (11) eleven mile post Thence North (56 1/2) fifty six and
 a half degrees West (120) one hundred and twenty rods
 Thence West (10 1/2) ten and a half degrees North (90)
 ninety rods Thence West (30 1/2) thirty and one half
 degrees North (16) sixteen rods to a ditch fence between the
 farms of Bartons & Childers Thence West (94) ninety four
 rods on the line of said farms to the (12) twelve
 mile stake Thence West on the same line (124) one
 hundred and twenty four rods Thence North (6 1/2)
 six and a half degrees on the East side of Telmans farm Thence
 North (4 1/2) four and a half degrees West (100)
 one hundred and eight rods to the section line that
 runs East and West and is one mile south of the township
 line parallel with it Thence West (26) twenty six rods
 to the (13) thirteen mile post Thence West one mile
 to the (14) fourteen mile post Thence West (109) one
 hundred and nine rods to the county road
 running from the Iowa Settlement and Lagrange then
 on said road North (131) one hundred and thirty one
 rods to a fifteen mile post Thence (190) one hundred and
 ninety rods North to the Grande Ronde River thence
 (70) seventy rods on the East side of Pochets ranch
 to a mound thence leaving said road and
 running West (6 1/2) six and a half degrees North (54)
 fifty four rods to the (16) sixteen mile post thence

West (240) two hundred and forty rods Thence
 West (29) twenty nine degrees South (80) eighty rods
 to the (17) seventeen mile post Thence West 29 South
 (the same course) (68) sixty eight rods to the road crossing
 the bridge at Oadel thence South (3) three rods to
 said bridge this point of termination
 The commencement and terminus of the road are
 shown the size required by law Marked R each mile
 post is marked with a figure corresponding with the
 distance followed by the letter M the chain was measured
 at the commencement and once during the time it was
 in use and found to be correct the variation allowed of
 the Compass was 1 1/2 West

Attached to this report is
 a plat of the road drawn on a scale of 2 inches to
 the mile I also certify that I have been
 necessarily employed on the surveying and making
 the plat and report of the road six days and
 have complied with the law made and provided for
 that purpose to the best of my ability

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the prayer of the petitioners for a County Road heretofore annexed be not granted and allowed the above obligations

Benjamin Stanton and John Wright their heirs and assigns will pay or cause to be paid to the County of Union aforesaid all cost and expenses which may be incurred by reason of the view and survey of said Road, if the prayer of the petitioners aforesaid is granted and allowed then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

Coane were appointed viewers and Daniel Chaplin Surveyor. to meet on the 19th day of May 1866 at Credell for the purpose of viewing said Road.

In the matter of a petition for a County Road from the town of Credell ^{the north east corner of the town of 2 1/2 miles} to ^{the town of Union} Coane F. Hodine Thomas Babbington were appointed viewers and M C Isreal Surveyor to meet on the 24th day of May 1866 at Union for the purpose of viewing said Road

The Petition of Mathew Rice for license to sell spiritous liquors in less quantities than one quart was received and it appearing that proper notice had been given and Bonds filed It is thereupon ordered that license be granted to said Mathew Rice to sell spiritous liquors in less quantities than one quart for the term of six months from date hereof by the payment of the sum of \$500 as required by law
