Know All Men By These Presents, That we, Q.V. Witty

and O.W. Thompson of the county of Union and State of Oregon, are held and firmly bound unto said County of Union in the full sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents.

Signed this 28th day of January A. D. 1901 I901.

Now, the conditions of the above obligation are such, that whereas, Q.V. Witty and O.W. Thompson and others have petitioned the County Court of said County of Union, at the March term, 1901, thereof, for a County Road, described in the petition and notice hereto annexed, as follows:

To narrow all of the County roads in Road District No. 38 in the County of Union, State of Oregon, to forty (40) feet in width.

Now, if the above named Q.V. Witty and O.W. Thompson shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, all costs and expenses that may be incurred by reason of the view or review of said road, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted or allowed, then that this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
