Commencing at a point at the northeast corner of the southwest quarter of section Twenty-eight Twp 1 North Range 40 E W M in Union County running thence in a southeasterly direction to a point about forty rods south of the Northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said section Twenty-eight thence on a line due south about twenty rods to a point intersecting with said county road, thus altering said County road from a direct line between the above starting point and terminating point to the route as above described

and Wm. Keffer of the county of Union and State of Oregon, are held and firmly bound unto said County of Union in the full sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents.

Signed this 13th day of May A. D. 1906.

Now, the conditions of the above obligation are such, that whereas,

Isaac Bungardner and others have petitioned the County Court of said County of Union, at the June term, 1906, thereof, for a County Road, described in the petition and notice hereto annexed, as follows: Commencing at a point where the present county road strikes the north line of the northeast quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33 Twp. 1 N. R. 40 E.W.M., thence running east to the Northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of above section thence south along said section line to where it intersects the present county road; and vacating the present county road between the above mentioned points.
