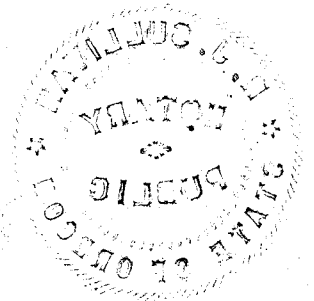

Gentlemen:-

I have given the matter of the petition of W..J. Case, et al, ostensibly made for the closing of a road, further attention, since you have referred the matter to me a second time. On September 15th, 1916, I made and filed with you my opinion on the proceedings and, in effect, reported favorably thereon. At the time of making said report I had before me a copy of the petition, as posted, to which was attached affidavits showing the necessary and legal posting.

The file now before me contains the original petition containing the original signatures, which was filed with the clerk of the county court on May 31, 1916. For said purpose a printed form was used and the words "lay out, alter and establish" are scratched out with a pen and no words substituted for the eliminated words. The petition thus reads,- "The undersigned freeholders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the road district where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your honorable body,---- the county road within said county on the following line or route, to-wit: (Describing same)". I am unable to approve said petition for the same ^{as} I do not believe ^{it} confers any jurisdiction on the court to act,- and this though the word "closing" has been written on the top of the petition.

I feel impelled, therefore, to recommend the disallowance of the petition for these reasons.


I am returning herewith the papers in the matter of the vacation of the county road petitioned for by W.J. Case, et al, which matter was referred to me for opinion, with the information that in its present shape said record seems to show a compliance with the laws respecting notice and proof thereof.

On page 6 of the 1915 road laws, section 6280 of LOL is set forth, that section providing that when any petition shall be presented for the action of the county court for vacating any county road it shall be accompanied by satisfactory proof that notice has been given by advertisement posted in the place of holding county court (and also in three public places) notifying all persons concerned that application will be made as petitioned for.

Ordinarily, these affidavits of posting show how far from the ground the affidavits were posted on the post or tree and also that the same were in a conspicuous place, but I do not think the failure to do so invalidates the proof of advertisement. The petitioners have filed the bond prescribed by section 6296 found on page 12. Said section seems to indicate that proceedings for the vacation of a road upon view or review, shall be referred to the board of county road viewers, who are described in section 6281, set forth on page 6.. That section, however, says that it is the duty of that board to "lay out, alter or straighten" county roads. Taking all of these sections together, I am of the opinion that the better way would be for the court at this time to make an order referring the matter to the county road viewers, although as indicated, it may not be necessary. When the same has been referred and their report received procedure can then be taken in the usual manner.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application be granted; that the bond be approved and the Clerk of this Court is hereby authorized and directed to issue warehouseman's license to said applicants in conformity with this order.

In the matter of the application of J. W. Barger et al to open county road.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that this matter be, and the same is here now continued for the term.

In the matter of the application of S. F. Richardson to open L Street.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that this matter be, and the same is hereby continued for the term.
