Beginning at a point in the county road leading from Ladd Canyon to North Powder, at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, in Township 5 South, Range 39 East, W M and running thence in a South-westerly direction across the North Half of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 7, to a point about 30 rods North of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 7 thence in a Westerly direction across the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 7 to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 7, and there ending and terminating said proposed road following as nearly as practicable the line or route of that certain well defined private road which has been established and used across said lands for many years and which is commonly known as the Old Saw-mill Road That said proposed road be made forty feet in width, or such other width as the court may deem proper.

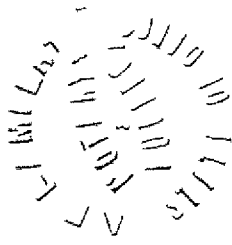
