I beg leave to report as follows; that I met the board of viewers as appointed and surveyed the proposed road for the whole distance thereof and the following Field Notes made by me are true and correct, and that the Plat accompanying the same is a true and correct representation of said road both together in angles and distances.

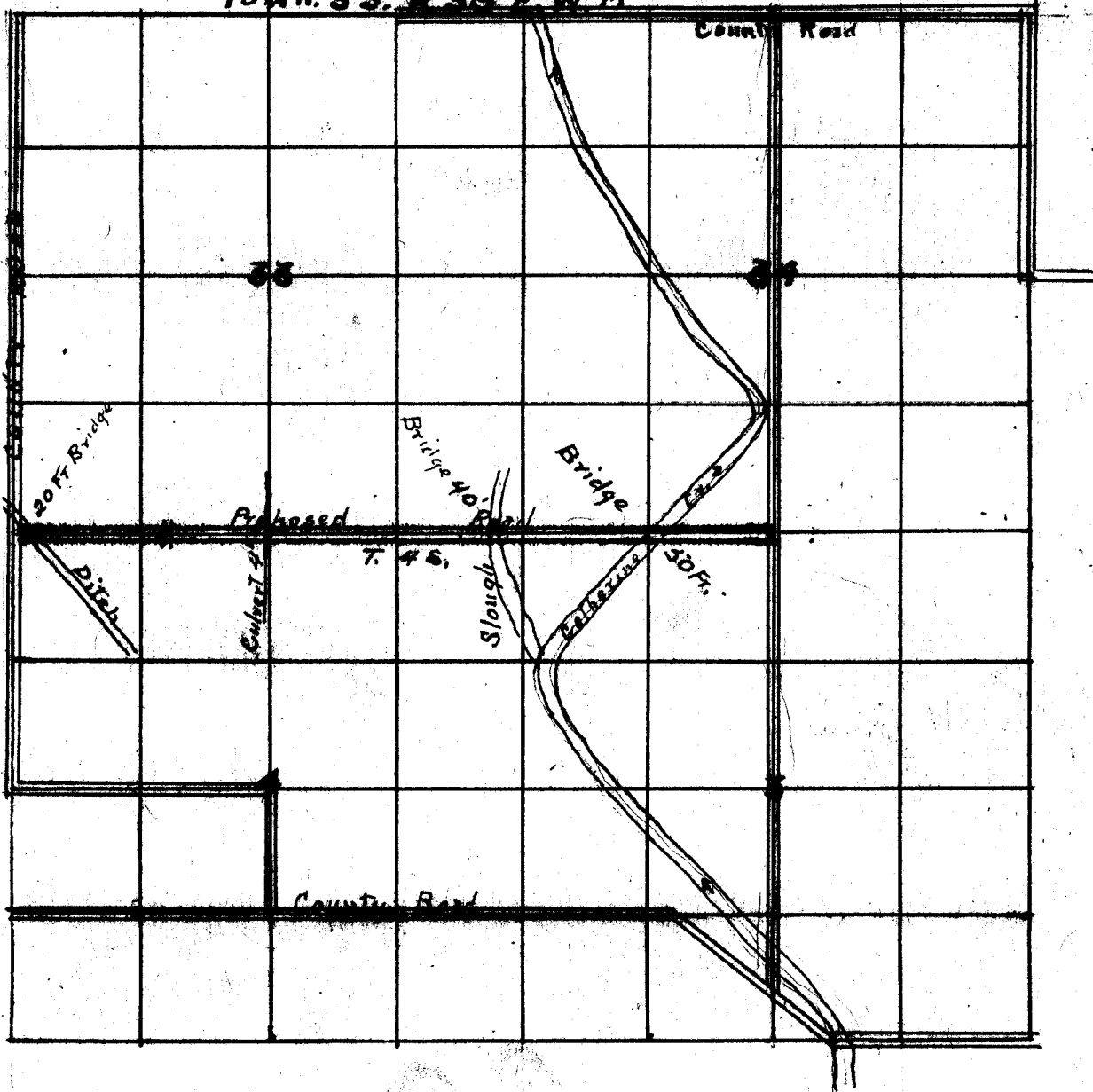
Commencing at the S. W. Cor. of Sec. 33 T. 3 S. R. 39 E. W. M. at a rock marked R. Thence east 40 ft. to ditch 20 ft. wide course N. S. 1500 ft ditch 16 ft. wide course North and South, 2663 ft. ditch 4 ft. wide and 1/4 sec. cor. stone. 4890 ft. to Slough 40 ft. wide course N. and S. ; 5327 ft. to sec. cor .marked rock and one mile. Thence east 1320 ft. Catherine Creek 50 ft. wide; then east 1320 ft. to 1/4 sec cor. on south line of sec. 34 T.3. S. R.39 E. W. M. and there terminate.
