TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore on the 14th day of April 1919, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Cyrus Williams et al., beg leave to report that on the 23rd day of April, 1920, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and make the following recommendations as to the width of the road and damages: That the road be 60 feet wide for its full length with the exception of that part between points 20 and 22 as shown on the blue print attached and for this distance that it be but 40 feet in width. 

W. 345 ft., thence N. 19 d. W. 244 ft., thence N. 7 d. 15 m. W. 256 ft., thence N. 2 d. W. 85 ft., thence N. 65 d. W. 139 ft., thence N. 55 d. W. 68 ft., thence N. 42 d. W. 230 ft., thence N. 31 d. W. 297 ft., thence N. 52 d. W. 346 ft., thence N. 75 d. 30 m. W. 360 ft., to the center line running north and South through section 30 in said Tp. 4, S. R. 40 E., thence North to the North line of said section 30, thence West $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the County Road, said road to be sixty feet in width.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve freeholders of this county, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court to wit, - at the Court House in the city of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to wit: - One on a board near the Wm. Ficklin cabin at the beginning of said proposed road; one on a fence post at the Tony Hempt place and one on a fence post at the terminus of said proposed road, for more than than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this court, at the present session of this court, and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the cost of this proceeding has been duly given.

It is therefore ORDERED that the County Surveyor, and W. E. Green and J. F. Hutchinson, constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, be and they are hereby directed to meet at Union, Oregon, on the 14th day of April, 1920, at the hour of 9 o'clock A. M., or within ten days thereafter and proceed to survey, view and lay out said road according to law.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said Board of County Road Viewers file its report with the Clerk of this Court on or before Saturday, April 24th, 1920.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that this matter be and the same is here now continued for the term.

In the matter of the establishment of a County Library Service.

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore on the 14th day of April, 1920, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Cyrus Williams et al, beg leave to report that on the 23rd day of April, 1920, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said County and make the following recommendations as to the width of the road and damages; that the road be 60 feet wide for its full length with the exception of that part between points 20 and 22 as shown on the blue print attached and for this distance that it be but 40 feet in width. That no damages be allowed excepting to M. F. Davis and we recommend that he be paid \$320.00.

E. Ricker in the sum of \$100.00, W. W. Langford in the sum of \$22.50, and M. F. Davis for \$100.00 in addition to the sum recommended by the Board of County Road Viewers, which claims were heard and considered and allowed as follows:- F. E. Ricker, \$75.00, W. W. Langford \$22.50, and M. F. Davis \$75.00 in addition to the allowance of \$320.00 recommended by the Viewers, making the total damages allowed said M. F. Davis the sum of \$395.00 and there having been no cause shown why said proposed road should not be ordered opened and declared a public highway, and the Court being satisfied that said road will be of public utility, and all the files and records of this proceeding having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legality of said proceeding,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be accepted and placed on record; that said proposed road be and is hereby declared a public highway of Union County; that the Surveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road and his field notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the book of plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon; that said road be finally surveyed, opened, and placed in

repair for travel.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the County Clerk draw warrants on the General Fund of the County in favor of F. E. Ricker in the sum of \$75.00; W. W. Langford in the sum of \$22.50 and M. F. Davis in the sum of \$395.00 in payment of the damages sustained by them on account of said road.

In the matter of hauling contracts advertised for.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that this matter be and the same is hereby continued until Monday, May 10th, 1920 at 2 o'clock P. M.
