D. S. McComas Bill The Bill of D. S. McComas for services rendered Union County as Clerk was allowed and ordered audited amounting to \$46.20

Constable for Eagle Precinct In the matter of the Constable of Eagle Creek Precinct it appearing to the Court that there was a vacancy in said precinct in the said office the Court appointed John Lewis as Constable for said Precinct

D. B. Heskett a. p. In the matter of the assessor D. B. Heskett prayed the Court for more time to complete the assessment the Court granted him until the first Monday in October

The Court then adjourned until 2 O'clock P. M

At a regular term of the County Commissioners Court of Union County Oregon began and held at the Court House in La Grande on the 9th day of March 1867 There was present Hon. J. Alberson County Judge, P. Morton Commissioner, A. C. Craig Sheriff and A. Warnick's Deputy County Clerk

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made three times at the door by the sheriff the following business was then had

In the Matter of }
a County Road }

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for the location of a County road beginning one mile and a half west of Union Town running south three hundred yards thence westerly one half a mile thence on the nearest and best ground to intersect the County road running from La Grande to the Ladd Hill. The Court ordered the Petition read as provided for in the code which was done

In the Matter of the Appointing }
of Viewers of a Change in Road }

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for the vacation of a portion of a County road recently established and running from La Grande to Summerville to commence at C. Street near the dwelling house of S. D. Reinhardt thence North to the N. E. corner of D. Chaplins land claim thence E. 20 chains thence North to the point where the road leading from La Grande to Summerville intersects the same on W. W. Bakers east line. also commencing at the south end of the lane at Probstels North to the Bluff. Mr Robert Palmer James McDonald and Geo N. Clark were chosen as viewers to Meet at La Grande the 16th day of March 1867 D. Chaplain was appointed surveyor

Court met pursuant to adjournment same officers present due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following business was transacted.

Billiard Licence

Wiram McCauley having presented a receipt from the County Treasurer for the sum of Twenty five dollars and made application for a licence to let for him a Billiard Table, it is ordered by the Court that a licence issue to the said Wiram McCauley for the said purpose for the term of six months.

Qualifying of County Treasurer

Now at this time came J. L. Morrow who having been duly appointed as County Treasurer and having filed bonds which were first approved by the Court and also having been duly qualified by the said J. L. Morrow is therefore declared to be Treasurer of Hermon County.

In the matter of a County Road

Now at this time was presented the report of the Surveyor and Chain carrier of a County road commencing one and one half miles west of the town of Union running South three Hundred yards thence north one half mile thence by the nearest and most practicable route to intersect the road leading over the Lead Hill which report was accepted and it is ordered that said road be ordered opened as a County Road.
