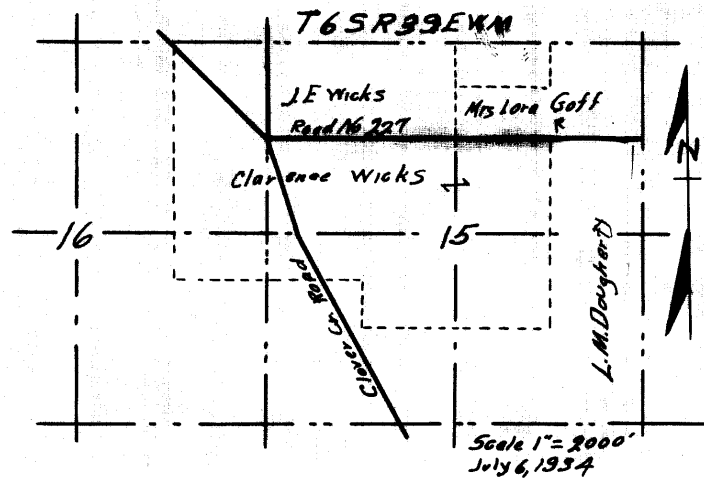

Road No. 227 has been fenced off and has not been used for the last four years. It would require two culverts and a great deal of expense for grading to put this road in condition for travel.

Due to the fact that road No. 227 has been closed with gates at either end and has not been used for the past four years, I recommend that it be closed officially as a county road of Union County, Oregon.





Now at this time the above entitled matter comes on for hearing the report of the County Engineer on the proposed vacation of a portion of County Road No. 273, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the NE corner of Section 4 Tp 6S, R39, EWM, which point is marked 2M A2 in the original field notes; thence East 20° South 320 rods to a post marked A3 3M; thence east 19° 15' South a distance of 132 rods to A4; thence West 48° South 16 rods to a post marked A5; thence South 9 rods; thence South 35° East 12 rods to a post marked A6; thence East 20° South 151 rods to a post marked 4M, which point is the Southeast corner of Section 9 Tp 6S, R39, EWM; and it appearing to the Court from the report of the County Engineer that the portion of said road proposed to be vacated has been replaced insofar as public convenience is concerned by an improved market road and that that portion of said road proposed to be vacated is seldom used and is burdensome to maintain and is no longer useful as a part of the general road system of Union County; and it further appearing from the affidavit of posting on file in this proceeding, that the County Engineer, more than 30 days prior to September 6th, 1934, the date set for hearing said Engineer's report on said proposed vacation, posted 3 notices of the date set for hearing said report in the vicinity of that portion of said road proposed to be vacated, and one notice at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: at the Court House in the city of La Grande, Oregon; and it further appearing that no person has appeared to object to the vacation of that portion of said road described herein, and that no remonstrance has been filed,

It is therefore CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that said road be and the same is hereby vacated between the points and along the line described herein.
