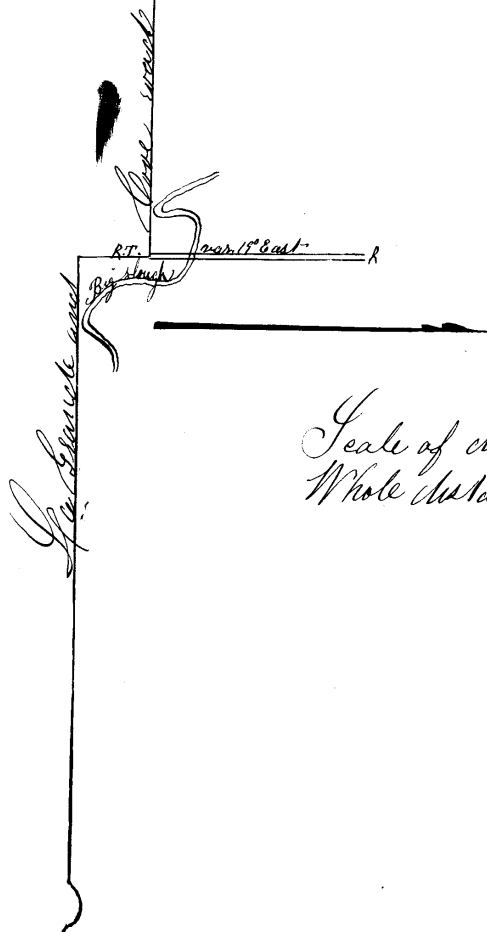

Beginning at a post marked R. placed at the center of Sec. 5. Town 3 South, Range 38 East. Thence ~~North~~ South 120 chains to post marked R.T. placed at the center of the North line of Sec. 17. and intersecting a proposed County road between La Gravelle and Cove.

road.

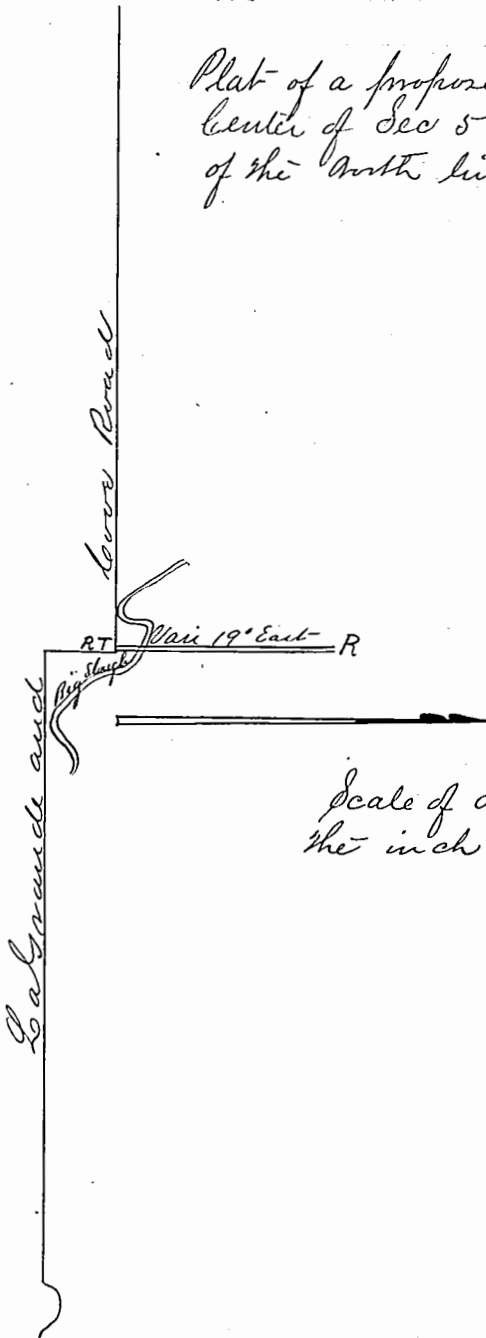
