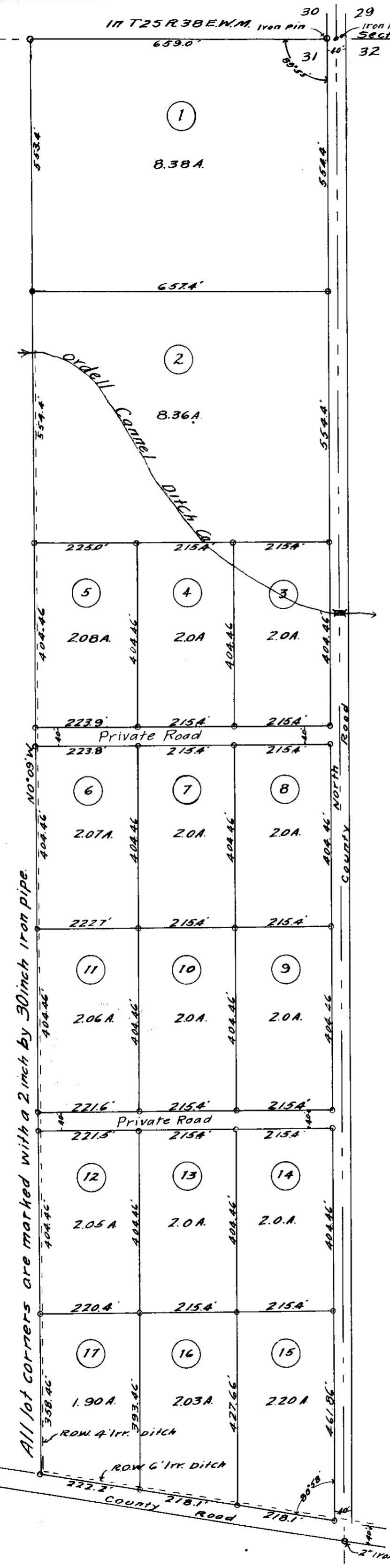


ANDERSON ACRES ON THE BLACKHAWK TRAIL

That we the undersigned in consideration of the benefits to accrue have platted the land described in the accompanying plat into tracts, and we have dedicated for private use the roads shown thereon, also a strip of land four feet and six feet in width, have been reserved for irrigation ditch purposes, as indicated on the accompanying plat all tracts are of the size indicated.
